
Marie Antoinette's wig pin cushion by Rosy Alice Crochet Design @ Ravelry

You will need:

Grey or silver yarn
Tapestry needle
Coloured yarn or ribbon to make bows
Beads or old earrings, etc, to embellish

Stitches used:

UK Double crochet (dc) = US Single crochet UK Double crochet 2 together (dc2tog) = US Single crochet 2 together (sc2tog).



Round 1: 10 dc into circle.

Round 2: 20 dc into each stitch from round 1.

Round 3: 20 dc into front loops only.

Round 4: 20 dc into each stitch from previous round.

Rounds 5 - 17: Repeat round 4.

Stuff.

Now we work in a spiral. Crochet dc2tog repeatedly until you can't any more! Fasten off and sew in ends.

Cut two pieces of coloured yarn or ribbon about 17 cm long. Using a tapestry needle, sew them around the outside of your wig pin cushion a few rows apart as shown in the photo and tie the ends in a bow.

Add anything else you'd like to decorate. I've used earrings!
