INSPIRATION

The scarf was inspired by <u>Aromy's Cabled Scarflette</u>, just a bit longer, with an added cable and single toggle-based closure. It was made for Steve - a Midlands based plumber.

DIFFICULTY

Easy cable pattern, suitable for beginners.

SIZE

One-size, small & burly

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

62 x 40 cm (24.4" x 15.7")

MATERIALS

I used a skein of chunky brown wool from my stash. Sadly it was un-labeled, so can't provide too many details, but it is similar to King Cole Value Chunky in Copper.

1 set of US 10 /6mm straight needles

Cable needle (or a single double pointed needle)

Yarn needle

Toggle / button of choice

PATTERN NOTES

ABBREVIATIONS:

SI slip

C4f SI 4 sts onto the cable needle and hold towards the front of work, K4, K4 from cable needle.

CO cast on

BO bind off

PATTERN

Begin by casting on 29 stitches.

Row 1: Kall

Row 2-6: Slip 1st stitch purlwise, K all

Row 7: SI purlwise, K2, SI, K10, P, K10, SI, K3

Row 8: SI purlwise, K2, P, K, P8, K3, P8, K, P, K3

Row 9-16: Repeat Rows 7 & 8 four more times

Row 17: SI purlwise, K2, SI, K, C4f, K, P, K, C4f, K, SI, K3

Row 18: SI purlwise, K2, P, K, P8, K3, P8, K, P, K3

Row 19-30: Repeat Rows 7 & 8 six times

Row 31-32: Repeat Rows 17 & 18

Row 33-44: Repeat Rows 7 & 8 six times

Row 45-46: Repeat Rows 17 &18

Row 47-58: Repeat Rows 7 & 8 six times

Row 59-60: Repeat Rows 17 &18

Row 61-72: Repeat Rows 7 & 8 six times

Row 73-74: Repeat Rows 17 &18

Row 75-82: Repeat Rows 7 & 8 four times

Row 83: SI purlwise, K all

To make the button hole ...

Row 84: SI purlwise, K12, BO1, K1, BO1, K13

Row 85: SI purlwise, K13, Turn and CO2, Turn normal, K13

Then finally, to finish the border ...

Row 86-89: SI purlwise, K all

Row 90: BO loosely.

FINISHING

Lightly steam. Using the yarn needle sew in any loose ends and attach button.
