# Elephant & Walrus

### BLUE SKIES, COLD NIGHTS



#### INSPIRATION

Blue Skies, Cold Nights is less chunky and more light-weight than its predecessor, the sea-farer scarf. Designed to be worn on wet April days and cold spring evenings. Thank you Joe for the photos!

#### DIFFICULTY

Easy!

#### SIZE

One size, easily adjusted.

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 117cm/ 46" Width: by 14cm / 5.5"

#### MATERIALS

Patons Smoothie DK [100% acrylic; 100g skein]; color: 01058 (blue); 2 skeins

1 set(s) US #XX/4mm straight needles

Cable needle / 1 double pointed needle

Button / Toggle of choice

#### GAUGE

22 sts/30 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

#### PATTERN NOTES

#### ABBREVIATIONS:

**SI** slip

**C4b** sl 2 stitches to cable needle holding it at the back, K 2, K 2 from cable needle **C4f** sl2 stitches to cable needle holding it at the front, K2, K2 from cable needle

**CO** cast on

**BO** bind off

#### **PATTERN**

Begin by casting on 34 sts

Row 1: K all

Row 2-6: Slip 1st stitch purlwise, K all

Row 7: SI purlwise, K2, SI, K8, P1, K8, P1, K8, SI, K3

Row 8: SI purlwise, K2, P9, K1, P8, K1, P9, K3

Row 17: SI purlwise, K2, SI, C4b, C4f, P1, C4b, C4f, P1, C4b, C4f, SI, K3

Row 18: SI purlwise, K2, P9, K1, P8, K1, P9, K3

Row 19-22: Repeat Rows 7 & 8 twice

Continue repeating Rows 17-22 until scarf measures approx 112 cm/ 44.1" (or desired length).

SI purlwise, K all

Now create the button hole...

SI purlwise, K15, BO1, K1, BO1, K15 SI purlwise, K16, Turn and CO2, Turn normal, K15

Then, finally to finish the border:

SI purlwise, K all Repeat this row 3 times then BO loosely.

#### FINISHING

To complete, press the scarf lightly and sew on button
