# Sailor's Rib Beanie

# **Materials**

50g worsted weight (10ply) wool

- 4.5mm 40cm circular needles
- 4.5mm double pointed needles (dpns)

## Gauge

18sts = 10cm/4" in stocking stitch Four repeats of 5st Sailor's Rib = 12cm/4¾"

#### **Sizes**

Toddler, child, small adult 42 (48, 54)cm [16½(19, 21¼)"] Note: measurements are for unworn hat, will stretch to fit a head circumference several cms bigger.

## Sailor's Rib in the round

Rnds 1 & 2: k1tbl, p1, k2, p1 Rnds 3 & 4: k1tbl, p4

# Instructions

CO 70 (80, 90) stitches

Purl 2 rounds

Work 3 full repreats of the Sailor's Rib pattern, then work rounds 1 and 2 only Purl 2 rounds

Continue in stocking stitch until hat measures 10.5 (13, 15.5)cm [41/4 (5, 6)] from CO edge.

# Work decrease rounds as follows:

Rnd 1: \*K8, k2tog\* repeat to end of round

Rnd 2 and all even rounds: knit

Rnd 3: \*K7, k2tog\* repeat to end of round

Rnd 5: \*K6, k2tog\* repeat to end of round

Rnd 7: \*K5, k2tog\* repeat to end of round

Rnd 9: \*K4, k2tog\* repeat to end of round

Rnd 11: \*K3, k2tog\* repeat to end of round

Rnd 13: \*K2, k2tog\* repeat to end of round

Rnd 15: \*K1, k2tog\* repeat to end of round

Rnd 17: \*k2tog\* repeat to end of round

Switch to dpns or use magic loop when you have too few stitches to knit comfortably.



Cut yarn, thread tail onto sewing needle and through remaining sitches. Pull tight and fasten tail to inside of hat.

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
