Throughout the tutorials, the green yarn is color A and the brown yarn is color B.

These tutorials assume familiarity with the basics of brioche knitting. You can find full instructions for basic brioche in my Tidepool Hat pattern, which can be purchased on Knit Picks

The Tidepool Hat pattern also includes instructions and photo tutorials for Fisherman's Rib and for increases and decreases that are useful with Honeycomb Stitch.



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TWO-COLOR BRIOCHE

Honeycomb Stitch

Color B (brown) is worked on odd rounds. Color A (green) is worked on even rounds and is prominent on RS. These pictures show the first few rounds of honeycomb stitch after working a couple of inches of Fisherman's Rib.



1. (Odd round in B) Knit A stitch.



2. Knit B stitch. Note how L needle reaches through A shawl to reach B stitch.



3. Slip B shawl. Repeat steps 1-3 for odd rounds.



4. (Even round in A) With yarn to front, slip B stitch.



5. Work a yo over B st that was just slipped, bring yarn to front, and purl next stitch tog with its shawl. Repeat steps 4-5 for even rounds.
