

PHOTO TUTORIAL -

Two-Color Stockinette Brioché In The Round

This series of three tutorials includes:

- Part 1 Replacing Dropped Stitches
- ⇒ **Part 2 Increases--Right- and Left-Leaning**
- Part 3 Decreases--Right- and Left-Leaning

Throughout the tutorials, the blue yarn is MC and the white is CC.

These tutorials assume familiarity with the basics of brioche knitting. You can find full instructions for basic brioche in my Calliope sock pattern, which can be purchased from Twist Collective

Right-Leaning Increase



1. (Round 1 – MC) Work to marked MC (blue) column, knit R loop of MC st that is below the one on the needle. Sl the CC (white) shawl of the next MC st separately.



2. Knit the MC st without its shawl.

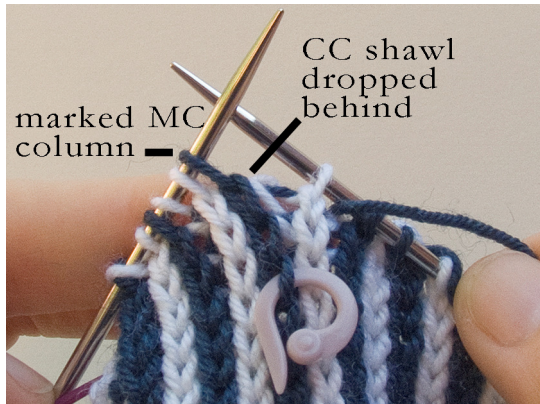


3. Round 1 complete. (This is actually a picture of a left-leaning increase, but the concept is similar.)



4. (Round 2 – CC) Work in patt except that the new CC st has no shawl and will be knit plain.

Left-Leaning Increase



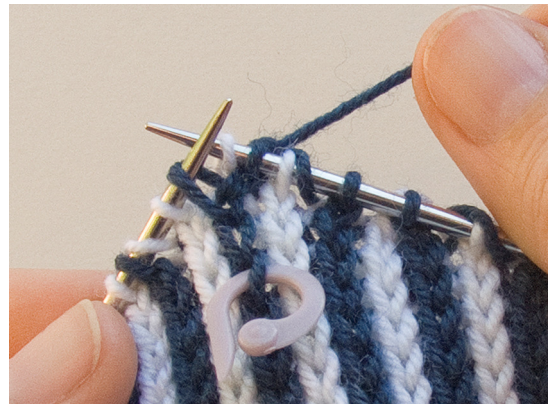
1. (Round 1 – MC) Work to marked MC (blue) column and drop CC (white) shawl behind.



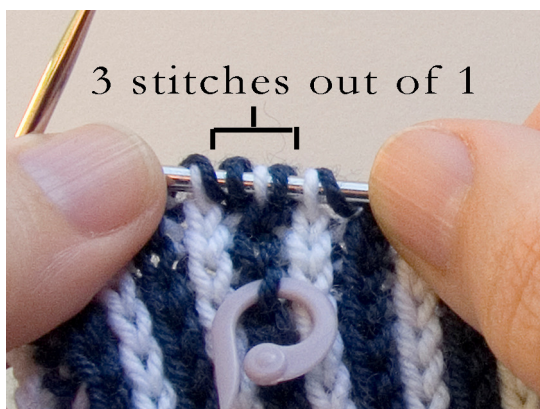
2. Knit the MC part of st and pick the CC shawl back up again.



3. Slip CC shawl to R needle.



4. Knit L loop of MC st 2 rows below.



5. Round 1 of increase complete.



6. (Round 2 - CC) Work in patt except that the new CC st has no shawl and will be knit plain. (This is actually a picture of a right-leaning increase, but the concept is similar.)
