This chart is to be used in the round or flat. the repeat is the grey highlighted section plus the six stitches to one side of it. Odd number rows represent the "A" section of the repeat, even rows represent the "B" section. The repeats differ depending on where you are in the pattern. You'll have to figure that out yourself.
