Coccoon Shrug


Cocoon Shrug

Size: Small

Note: For larger sizes, determine size needed, review the gauge measurement, and add additional cable repeats for width, as needed.



Finished Measurements



2 Coccoon Shrug

Materials

• Lion Brand Kool Wool [50% merino, 50% acrylic; 67 yds per 100g skein]; color: Eggplant, 8 skeins. (*Another good substitute would be Debbie Bliss Superchunky Cashmerino.*)

- 1 set US#11/6mm needles
- 1 cable hook
- · Stitch holders
- Yarn needle

Gauge

12 sts x 15 rows/4 in (of Long Wraparound Piece Cable Pattern)

Stitch Pattern

C6F = Slip 3 sts to cable needle and hold to the front of work, knit next 3 stitches, then knit the 3 stitches from the cable needle.

Back Rectangle Piece Cable Pattern:

Rows 1, 3, 5, 7: P2, K3, P6, K3, P6, K3, P6, K3, P6, K3, P6, K3, P6, K3, P2.

Row 2: K2, P3, C6F, P3, C6F, P3, C6F, P3, C6F, P3, C6F, P3, C6F, P3, K2.

Row 4 and Row 6: K2, P3, K6, P3, K6, P3, K6, P3, K6, P3, K6, P3, K6, P3, K2.

Row 8: Repeat Row 2.

Repeat Rows 1 through 8 to work the cable pattern.

Long Wraparound Piece Cable Pattern:

Rows 1, 3, 5, 7: P2, K3, P6, K3, P6, K3, P6.

Row 2: K2, P3, C6F, P3, C6F, P3, K6.

Row 4 and Row 6: K2, P3, K6, P3, K6, P3, K6.

Row 8: Repeat row 2.

Repeat rows 1 through 8 to work the cable pattern.

Directions

Back Piece

CO 61 sts

Work in **Back Rectangle Cable Pattern** until 16 inches from beginning.

Bind off.

Long Wraparound Piece

CO 29 sts.


Work in Long Wraparound Piece Cable Pattern until 40 inches from beginning.

Bind off.

Finishing

Assembly



- 1. Fold Long Wraparound Piece in half to determine its center.
- 2. Align the center of this piece to the top center of the Back Piece (should be three center Purl stitches).
- 3. Secure the two pieces together with stitch markers (counting stitches to assure it will line up) and seam accordingly.
- 4. Attach ends of Long Wraparound Piece to the bottom sides of the Back Rectangle Piece.
- 5. Secure the sides together with stitch markers (counting stitches to assure it will line up) and seam accordingly.
- 6. Fold six-inch hem in half and sew to inside all the way around the Long Wraparound Piece.
- 7. Weave in all ends.
