
Either Way Cowl

Two ways. Both simple. Both amazing.





Cast on 100 stitches. Join to work in round.

Round 1: Knit all stitches.

Round 2: Purl all stitches.

Repeat rounds 1-2 two more times.

Repeat round I until 15 yards of yarn remain.

Repeat rounds 1-2 three times.

Bind off. Weave in ends.

Easiest Way

Try this way!

You'll need:

2 skeins Shepherd's Wool Crazy

• 16" circular needle, size 8 (5.0mm)

Tapestry needle

Gauge: 5 sts/inch (stockinette)



Use provisional cast on to cast on 100 stitches. Join to work in round.

Knit all stitches until 4 yards of yarn remain. Kitchener first and last rounds together.*

Weave in end.

* Use a spare needle to hold stitches
