Stripy Poncho By Stana D. Sortor



Finished measurements:

Each Rectangle: 37" (94 cm) long and 22" (56 cm) wide.

Shoulder Length: 22" (56 cm) Body Length: 34" (87 cm)

Yarn:

Approximately 1580 - 1800 yards / 1445 - 1646 meters of Worsted weight yarn in colors of your choice. Also approximately 435 yards / 398 meters of Fun furry or similar type of novelty yarn.

For this specific color theme use:

MC – periwinkle (approximately 350 yards / 311 meters)

C1 – dark blue (approximately 220 yards / 202 meters)

C2 – white (approximately 290 yards / 265 meters)

C3 – purple (approximately 210 yards / 192 meters)


C4 – dark green (approximately 145 yards / 133 meters)

C5 – light blue (approximately 220 yards / 202 meters)

C6 – fun furry (hold double) (approximately 290 yards / 265 meters) plus approximately 145 yards / 133 meters for crochet edge. Or approximately 145 yards / 133 meters if using worsted yarn.

Recommended Needle Size: Circular Knitting Needles 24" or 36" US #7/4.5mm

Notions: Yarn needle, scissors, stitch marker, crochet hook.



Knit in the direction the arrows point.

Abbreviations:

K = Knit

 $\mathbf{P} = \text{Purl}$

Note:

This poncho is knitted flat in stockinette stitch with ribbing along the outer edge in two rectangles which are joint together. Sew them together making sure the ribbing is on the outer edge of the poncho. With a crochet hook make a chain along the edge for a nice finish in double held Fun furry yarn.

Gauge: 18 sts & 21 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch.



INSTRUCTIONS:

Rectangle (make 2):

CO 100 sts in C6.

Rows 1 – 4: Knit in C6. Cut off C6. Attach MC.

From now, work in stockinette stitch pattern and ribbing pattern repeating these two rows, except the last 4 rows (Row 191 - 194).

All odd rows: K90, (P1, K1)5x

All even rows: (P1, K1) 5x, P90

Working as follow:

Rows 5 – 12: Work in MC. Cut off MC. Attach C1.

Rows 13 – 14: Work in C1. Attach C2.

Rows 15 – 16: Work in C2. Attach C1.

Rows 17 – 18: Work in C1. Cut off C1.

Rows 19 – 22: Work in C2. Cut off C2. Attach C3.

Rows 23 – 28: Work in C3. Cut off C3. Attach C4.

Rows 29 – 32: Work in C4. Cut off C4. Attach MC.

Rows 33 – 38: Work in MC. Cut off MC. Attach C5.

Rows 39 – 46: Work in C5. Cut off C5. Attach C2.

Rows 47 – 48: Work in C2. Attach C6.

Rows 49 – 50: Work in C6. Cut off C6.

Rows 51 – 54: Work in C2. Cut off C2. Attach C1.

Rows 55 – 60: Work in C1. Cut off C1. Attach C3.

Rows 61 – 62: Work in C3. Cut off C3. Attach C5.

Rows 63 – 66: Work in C5. Cut off C5. Attach C4.

Rows 67 – 68: Work in C4. Cut off C4. Attach C2.

Rows 69 – 74: Work in C2. Attach MC.

Rows 75 – 76: Work in MC.

Rows 77 – 78: Work in C2. Cut off C2.

Rows 79 – 84: Work in MC. Attach C1.

Rows 85 – 86: Work in C1.

Rows 87 – 88: Work in MC. Cut off MC.

Rows 89 – 90: Work in C1. Cut off C1. Attach C6.

Rows 91 – 94: Work in C6. Cut off C6. Attach C3.

Rows 95 – 100: Work in C3. Cut off C3. Attach C5.

Rows 101 – 104: Work in C5. Attach C2.

Rows 105 – 106: Work in C2.

Rows 107 – 108: Work in C5. Cut off C5.

Rows 109 – 110: Work in C2. Cut off C2. Attach C4.

Rows 111 –114: Work in C4. Cut off C4. Attach MC.

Rows 115 – 122: Work in MC. Cut off MC. Attach C1.

Rows 123 – 126: Work in C1. Attach C3.

Rows 127 – 128: Work in C3.

Rows 129 – 130: Work in C1.

Rows 131 – 132: Work in C3. Cut off C3.

Rows 133 – 134: Work in C1. Attach C5.

Rows 135 – 136: Work in C5.

Rows 137 – 138: Work in C1. Cut off C1.

Rows 139 – 144: Work in C5. Cut off C5. Attach C2.

Rows 145 – 148: Work in C2. Cut off C2. Attach C6.

Rows 149 – 150: Work in C6. Cut off C6. Attach MC.

Rows 151 – 154: Work in MC. Cut off MC. Attach C3.

Rows 155 – 160: Work in C3. Cut off C3. Attach C4.

Rows 161 – 162: Work in C4. Cut off C4. Attach C2.

Rows 163 – 170: Work in C2. Cut off C2. Attach C1.

Rows 171 – 174: Work in C1. Cut off C1. Attach C5.

Rows 175 – 176: Work in C5. Cut off C5. Attach C4.

Rows 177 – 178: Work in C4. Attach MC.

Rows 179 – 180: Work in MC.

Rows 181 – 182: Work in C4. Cut off C4.

Rows 183 – 188: Work in MC. Cut off MC. Attach C3.

Rows 189 – 190: Work in C3. Cut off C3. Attach C6.

Rows 191 – 194: Knit in C6.

Row 195: Bind off.

Finishing

Sew together the two rectangles, making sure the ribbing is along the outside edge. Crochet a chain with Fun furry yarn along the outer edge. Weave in ends, wash and block to Finished Measurements.
