## Autumnal Equinox Blanket <br> By Stana D. Sortor



Finished Size:
Square with 33 " / 84 cm long sides.

## Yarn:

Cascade 220 Superwash Sport Multis (100\% Superwash Merino Wool; 136 yards / 125 meters per 50g / 1.75oz)
\# 107 Browns (10 skeins)

## Yardage:

1300-1360 yards / 1189-1250 meters
Recommended Needle Size: Circular Needle US \# 5/3.75mm 36" long, Double Pointed Needles (DPN) US \#5/3.75mm (set of 5).

Notions: Yarn needle, scissors, stitch marker.

## Abbreviations:

KFB - Knit in front and back of the same stitch, this creates two stitches from one stitch.
SSK - slip stitch, slip stitch and knit the two stitches together, this decreases two stitches to one stitch.
DPN - Double Pointed Needles
Sl. St. - Slip stitch from left to right needle without knitting it.
Technique:
This blanket is knitted in one piece. Start from one corner, increasing every other row on one side. Continue with decrease at every other row until you have only 1 sts left. Continue by picking up stitches along the longer side of the triangle. Continue knitting with decrease at the beginning of each row until you have 1 stitch left. The blanket is finished with I-cord all around for a nice finish.

## I-cord technique.

With MC yarn and double pointed needle cast on 3 additional sts on left needle. Pick up 1 st through the edge. Position the yarn behind and work as follows:
Knit first 2 sts. Knit next 2 sts together. Return the 3 sts back onto left needle and repeat. Continue to work in I-cord attaching the I-cord along the edge of the entire blanket. In every corner continue I-cord for 1 row without attaching it to your work, this will make the corner turn easier. Continue the I-cord, attaching it around the edge until you reach the beginning of your I-cord. Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail, and thread the end on a yarn needle. Pull the end through the remaining stitches on the needles, gather up and close the hole, stitch to secure.

Gauge: 24 sts \& 33 rows $=4 "$ in stockinette stitch.

## INSTRUCTIONS:

First triangle part:
With the yarn and circular needle, cast on 2 sts. Place the stitch marker on the first st and work as follow:
Row 1, 2: Knit 1, Sl.st.
Row 3: KFB, Sl.st. (3 sts total)
Row 4: Knit 2, Sl.st.
Row 5: KFB, Knit 1, Sl.st. (4 sts total)
Row 6: Knit 3, Sl.st.
Row 7: KFB, Knit 2, Sl.st. (5 sts total)
Row 8: Knit 4, Sl.st.
Row 9: KFB, Knit 3, Sl.st. (6 sts total)
Row 10: Knit 5, Sl.st.
Row 11: KFB, Knit 4, Sl.st. (7 sts total)
Row 12: Knit 6, Sl.st.
Row 13: KFB, Knit 5, Sl.st. (8 sts total)
Row 14: Knit 7, Sl.st.
Row 15: KFB, Knit 6, Sl.st. (9 sts total)
Row 16: Knit 8, Sl.st.
Row 17: KFB, Knit 7, Sl.st. (10 sts total)
Row 18: Knit 9, Sl.st.
Row 19: KFB, Knit 8, Sl.st. (11 sts total)
Row 20: Knit 10, Sl.st.
Row 21 - 248 :
Continue in established pattern, increasing 1 sts every odd row, until you have 125 sts total
Row 249: SSK, Knit 122, Sl.st. (124 sts total)
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Row 250: Knit 123, Sl.st.
Row 251: SSK, Knit 121, Sl.st. (123 sts total)
Row 252: Knit 122, Sl.st.
Row 253: SSK, Knit 120, Sl.st. (122 sts total)
Row 254: Knit 121, Sl.st.
Row 255: SSK, Knit 119, Sl.st. (121 sts total)
Row 256: Knit 120, Sl.st.
Row 257: SSK, Knit 118, Sl.st. (120 sts total)
Row 258: Knit 119, Sl.st.
Row 259-494:
Continue in established pattern, decreasing 1 sts every odd row, until you have 2 st left.

## Second triangle:

Turn the work and pick up stitches along the long side of triangle to have 246 sts total.
Continue to work as follow:
Row 1: SSK, Knit 243, Sl.st. (245 sts total)
Row 2: SSK, Knit 242, Sl.st. (244 sts total)
Row 3: SSK, Knit 241, Sl.st. (243 sts total)
Row 4: SSK, Knit 240, Sl.st. (242 sts total)
Row 5: SSK, Knit 239, Sl.st. (241 sts total)
Row 6: SSK, Knit 238, Sl.st. (240 sts total)
Row 7: SSK, Knit 237, Sl.st. (239 sts total)
Row 8: SSK, Knit 236, Sl.st. (238 sts total)
Row 9: SSK, Knit 235, Sl.st. (237 sts total)
Row 10: SSK, Knit 234, Sl.st. (236 sts total)
Row 11-245:
Continue in established pattern, decreasing 1 sts every row, until you have 1 st left.

## Attaching the I-cord:

With yarn and double pointed needle cast on 3 additional sts on left needle. Position the yarn behind and work as follows:
Knit first 2 sts. Knit next 2 sts together. This decreases the 2 sts to 1 st.
Pick up 1 st through the edge. Return the 3 sts back onto left needle. Position the yarn behind and work as follows:
Knit first 2 sts. Knit next 2 sts together. Return the 3 sts back onto left needle and repeat.
Continue to work in I-cord attaching the I-cord along the edge of the entire blanket. In every corner continue I-cord for 1 row without attaching it to your work, this will make the corner turn easier.
Continue the I-cord, attaching it around the edge until you reach the beginning of your I-cord. Cut the yarn, leaving a long tail, and thread the end on a yarn needle. Pull the end through the remaining stitches on the needles, gather up and close the hole, stitch to secure.
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## Finishing:

Weave in the ends.
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
