



# Diamondy

This simple sock pattern combines a small lace inset with basic sock construction for an easy knit that shows off semi-solid yarns.

# Diamondy



## Cuff

Cast on 64 [72, 80] stitches and join in the round, being careful not to twist. Place a marker at the beginning of the round.

Ribbing Round: \*k1tbl, p1\* around

Work twisted 1x1 ribbing as described above for 10 rounds or desired length, then knit one round. Continue to Leg.

## Leg

Work the Lace Inset over the first 11 stitches according to the chart or written instructions below, knit 21 [25, 29] stitches, work the Lace Inset again, knit to end of round.

**Sizes:** Womens' small [medium, large]

## Finished Measurements:

8 [9, 10]" leg circumference

**Yarn:** Sunshine Yarns Classic Sock [100% superwash merino wool, 370 yards per 100g skein (sample shown in Jungle Green)] or similar fingering weight yarn

**Needles:** US 1.5 (2.5mm) circular or dpns, as desired. Use size appropriate to achieve stated gauge.

**Supplies:** tapestry needle, stitch markers

**Gauge:** 32 sts and 44 rows = 4" (10cm) in stockinette stitch

## Abbreviations:

k – knit  
k2tog – knit 2 sts together, right leaning decrease  
p – purl  
p2tog – purl 2 sts together  
pm – place marker  
sl – slip  
ssk – slip next 2 sts knitwise separately, insert left needle into the front loops and knit together, left-leaning decrease  
st(s) – stitch(es)  
yo –

## Lace Inset

Round 1: P2, k2tog, (k, yo) x 2, k, ssk, p2.  
Round 2, 4, 6, and 8: P2, k7, p2.  
Round 3: P2, k2tog, yo, k3, yo, ssk, p2.  
Round 5: P2, k, yo, ssk, k, k2tog, yo, k, p2.  
Round 7: P2, k2, yo, sl1, k2tog, pssso, yo, k2, p2.



Continue working the leg as described until the Lace Inset pattern has been worked eight times, or until leg is desired length before the heel flap. End after working Round 8 of the chart or written instructions.

Reposition stitches as follows before beginning heel flap. Knit 5 stitches from the instep needle(s) onto the heel needle(s) - (past the beginning of the round). Turn and \*sl 1, then purl 31 [35, 39] stitches.

Five sts of the second lace inset have now been worked. Transfer the remaining 6 sts to the instep needle. Begin the heel flap.

### Heel Flap

The heel flap will be worked flat across these 32 [36, 40] of the 64 [72, 80] stitches.

Row 1: \*sl 1, k1\* repeat across

Row 2: sl 1, purl across

Knit these two rows a total of 16 times (32 rows) [18 times (36 rows), 20 times (40 rows)], then proceed to Heel Turn and Gusset.

### Heel Turn and Gusset

Row 1: sl 1 k 18 [20, 22], ssk, k1, turn

Row 2: sl 1, p 7 [7, 9], p2tog, p1, turn

Row 3: sl 1, knit to one stitch before gap, ssk, k1, turn

Row 4: sl 1, purl to one stitch before gap, p2tog, p1, turn

Repeat Rows 3 and 4 until all stitches have been worked, but do not slip first stitch on last purl row.

Knit across and pick up 17 [19, 21] gusset sts, knit across instep, and pick up 17 [19, 21] sts on the other side of the gusset. Knit to the center of the heel and place a marker.

The beginning of the round (BOR) is now located at the center of the heel. Decrease gusset stitches until 32[36, 40] sts remain, as follows:

Round 1: Knit to 3 stitches before instep, k2tog k1, knit across instep, k1 ssk.

Round 2: Knit.

### Foot

Work in stockinette stitch until foot is approximately 2 [2.5, 2.5]" less than desired final foot length. Begin Toe.

### Toe

For the toe decreases, the round will begin between the instep and sole stitches.

Round 1: K1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts on sole needle(s), k2tog, k1. K1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts on instep needle(s), k2tog, k1.

Round 2: Knit

Round 1: K1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts on instep needle(s), k2tog, k1. K1, ssk, knit to last 3 sts on sole needle(s), k2tog, k1.

Round 2: Knit

Work these two rounds a total of 6 [8, 10] times (40 total stitches remain) then work only Round 1 5 more times (20 total stitches remain).

### Finishing

Cut yarn leaving a long tail, graft stitches to close toe, and weave in ends.

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
