



## BLOSSOM EARRINGS

These earrings were inspired by my popular [Blossom Necklace pattern](#), and can be made in minutes with just a few snips of yarn. They could be embellished with embroidery as shown above, or with beads and sequins as shown below, for a little glitz.

**Skill level:** Intermediate

**Finished Measurements:**  
1" tall x 7/8" wide

### MATERIALS

**Yarn:** Berroco Ultra Alpaca Light,  
(a DK weight Alpaca and Wool Blend)

**Color A:** 28", Oceanic Mix, #4285

**Color B:** 12", Turquoise Mix,  
#4294

**Color C:** 6", Pea Soup Mix, #4275

**Hook size:** E/4 ( 3.50mm)

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, rust-proof pins, set of earring backs

### ABBREVIATIONS

**ch(s)**=chain(s)

**tr**= treble crochet

**sl st**= slip stitch

**st**= stitch

**yo**= yarn over hook

**lp**= loop

**rep**= repeat

## **INSTRUCTIONS**

**Blossom (make 2):** Using **Color A**, ch 3, then make [5 tr, ch 2, sl st] in first ch. Fasten off.

**Leaves:** Using **Color B**, insert hook into first ch of blossom (the st that the 5 tr's were worked into). Yo, pull up a lp, \*ch 3, sl st in 2nd ch and then in first ch, sl st back into same st in Blossom\*. Rep from \* to \* once. Fasten off. Rep these instructions for other Blossom.

**Blossom Detail:** Using **Color C**, make a “lazy daisy” embroidery stitch in the middle of each blossom. Instructions on how to do this stitch can be found at: <http://crochet.about.com/library/weekly/aalazydaisy.htm>

**Finishing:** Weave in all loose ends with a tapestry needle. Block by pinning with rust-proof pins on an ironing or blocking board, spray with water and allow to dry before removing pins. Glue Blossoms to earring backs.
