

Simple Lacy Hat By stolenpostit

Materials

- 105g of sport weight yarn. Shown in Classic Elite Yarns Fresco in Superman Yellow.
- 3.25 mm double pointed needles.
- Tapestry needle for weaving in ends.

Gauge: 6st = 1 inch

Fits adult-sized head. This pattern yields a very stretchy hat, and can be adapted to different gauges and yarn weights by 15 cast-on stitches.

Stitch Key

k = knit

p = purl

yo = yarn over

ssk = slip slip knit; slip the next two stitches onto the right needle without working them, knit the next stitch, slip the slipped stitches over the knit stitch

s2tog = knit the next two stitches together

s2kp2sso = slip the next two stitches as if to k2tog, knit the next stitch, pass the two slipped stitches over the knit stitch

The stitch numbers written in the pattern are based on a 120-stitch cast on.





Cast On: 120 stitches

Ribbing:

k2 p3* around for 12 rows.

Lace Pattern

1: Knit around.

2: *k1, yo, ssk, k3, yo, s2kp2sso, yo, K3, k2tog, yo, knit* around – 120st

→repeat two rows until piece measures about 5.5” from cast on, or until desired. I repeated the pattern 20 times.

Decreases

1 and all odd rows up to 13: knit around – 120 st

2: *k1, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, s2kp2sso, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1* around– 104 st

4: *k1, yo, ssk, k2tog, yo, s2kp2sso, yo, ssk, k2tog, yo, k1* around – 88st

6: *k1, yo, s2kp2sso, yo, s2kp2sso, yo, s2kp2sso, yo, k1* around – 72 st

8: *ssk, k1, yo, s2kp2sso, yo, k1, k2tog* around – 56st

10: *ssk, yo, p2kp2sso, yo, k2tog * around – 40 st

12: *ssk, k1, k2tog * around – 24 st

14: *ssk, k1 * around – 16 st

Cut yarn, thread tail through live stitches and pull closed. Weave in loose ends.



The hat shown above is made with worsted weight yarn, size 9 double-pointed needles, and a 75-stitch cast on.
