

# Gorge the Monster

A m i g u r u m i P a t t e r n

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## M a t e r i a l s

- Bulky Yarn in Green
- Worsted Weight Yarn in White and Beige
- Size G6/4.00 mm Crochet Hook
- Embroidery Needle
- Sewing Needle
- White Thread
- White Felt
- Scissors
- Polyester Fiberfill
- 9mm Plastic Eyes

## A b b r e v i a t i o n s

- R – Round
- Ch – Chain
- Sc – Single crochet
- St – Stitch
- Dec – Single crochet decrease (or single crochet 2 together)
- Sl st – Slip stitch
- Sk – Skip one stitch
- f.l.o. – Front Loops Only
- \*and\* – identifies a set of steps to be repeated as indicated in a round

This amigurumi is crocheted in rounds.

Gorge is approximately 4.5 inches tall (and about 4 inches wide).

## Eyes (Make 2)

Using white yarn...

R1: Ch 2, 6 sc in first chain. (6)

R2: 2 sc in each st. (12)

Sk 1, sl st and fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing.



## Spikes (make 3)

Using beige yarn...

R1: Ch 2, 4 sc in first chain. (4)

R2: \*Sc 1, 2 sc\* twice. (6)

R3: \*Sc 1, 2 sc\* repeat 3 times. (9)

R4: \*Sc 1, 2 sc \*repeat 4 times, sc 1. (13)

R5-6: Sc 13 around. (13)

Sk 1, sl st and fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing.

For middle spike, add a 7th round of 13 sc.

Flatten each piece so it looks triangular.

## Head/Body

Using green yarn...

R1: Ch 2, 7 sc in the first chain. (7)

R2: 2 sc in each st. (14)

R3: \*Sc in first st, 2 sc in next st\* repeat 7 times. (21)

R4: \*Sc 2, 2 sc in next st\* repeat 7 times. (28)

R5: \*Sc 3, 2 sc in next st\* repeat 7 times. (35)

R6-13: Sc 35 around.

R14: \*Sc 4, 2 sc in next st\* repeat 7 times. (42)

R15: Sc 42 around.

R16: \*Sc 5, 2 sc in next st\* repeat 7 times. (49)

R17-22: Sc 49 around.

R23: Sc 49 around f.l.o.

R24: \*Sc 5, dec 1\* repeat 7 times. (42)

R25: \*Sc 4, dec 1\* repeat 7 times. (35)

R26: \*Sc 3, dec 1\* repeat 7 times. (28)

Work on face somewhere around this time while decreasing. When the face is finished stuff him tightly and continue to stuff as you go!

R27: \*Sc 2, dec 1\* repeat 7 times. (21)

R28: \*Sc 1, dec 1\* repeat 7 times. (14)

Make sure he's really stuffed tightly!

R29: \*Dec 1\* repeat 7 times. (7)

R30: Sk 1, dec 1, sk 1, dec 1, sl st. Fasten off and weave in ends.



*I prefer to keep the amigurumi the way it looks as you go, not turning it inside out. For certain amigurumis I like the second look, but for this type of yarn, the fuzzy side with the strands floating about looks better.*





## Attachment

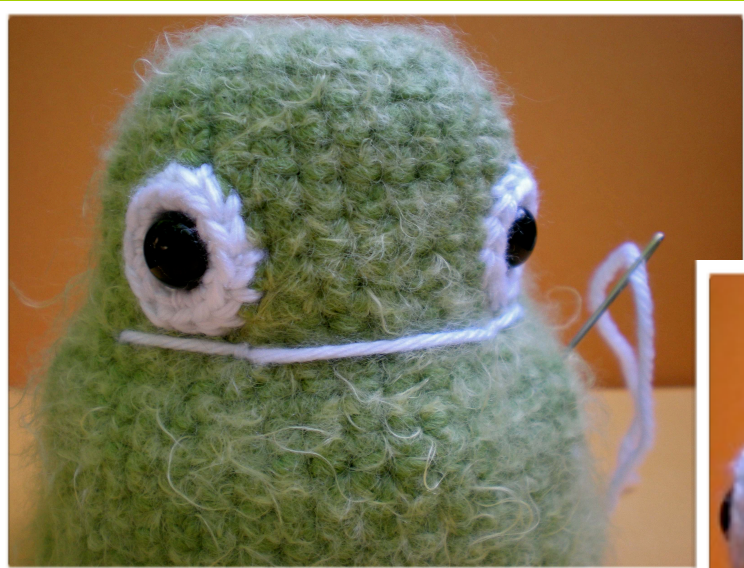
### Face:

- Place the plastic safety eyes into the centers of the white circle and place them in the head of your monster. I placed them between the 10th and 11th round and spaced them about 11 stitches apart.
- Sew the eyes on by using a whip stitch. I usually go through the center of each single crochet of the eyes.
- To create the mouth, pull white yarn along the “seam” of where the head/body starts to increase larger. The ends of the mouth should stretch past the width of the eyes or just under. The keep the mouth secure, make a small stitch over the strand of yarn in the places where the fangs will go.

- Cut out tiny triangles of white felt for the fangs. Sew them on top of the yarn where you placed the tiny stitches.

## Spikes:

Sew the spikes on the back in a straight line. I went through the center strands of the single crochets on either side as I sewed each on.



To hide the ends, tie a knot in a good place closely so its hidden, poke the yarn through and pull out from another spot. Pull the yarn firmly before snipping it off close to the body so the yarn gets pulled back into the poly-fiber fill.

The yarns I used for Gorge were  
Sensations Angel Hair Yarn in Light Green  
(head/body),  
Red Heart Eco-Ways recycled blend Yarn  
in Chamois (spikes) and  
Caron Simply Soft Eco Yarn in Soft White  
(mouth, eyes).
