Crochet Pattern HAIRCLIP FLOWER PATTERN

Skill level: Advanced beginner

Supplies needed:

Cotton crochet thread #10

Crochet Hook US#7 (1.50 mm)

Snap clip (2" long and just under 0.5" wide)

Yarn needle for weaving in ends

Abbreviations and stitches used:

- Ch-chain
- Dc double crochet
- Rnd-round
- Sc single crochet
- Sl st slip stitch



1. Ch 5.



2. Work in rnds using ch-5 as a foundation. Work into loops marked with red dots first. Continue working on the other side (loops marked with yellow dots).



3. Rnd 1: Sc in 4 next ch, starting with 2nd ch from hook.



4. (continue working on the other side of chain)



5. 1 sc in same ch, sc in next 3 ch.



6. Rnd 1 compete.



7. Rnd 2-4: sc in ea sc.



8. Turn the "hat" right side out. Use the dull side of hook to invert it.



9. The clip "hat" is ready to be attached.



10. Ch 4.



11. attach "hat" to the clip as shown.



12. Feed the ch-4 through the "snap leg".



13. Make a slip stitch where shown.



14. Follow instructions to secure hat in place.



15. Make a sc into next sc (marked with yellow dot), sc into ch-4 and next sc together (marked with red line), sc into next sc (marked with green dot).



16. This is a close up of connecting stitch made over the red line in previous step.



17. Slip stitch in next st.



18. Ch 4 and fasten off.



19. Insert hook through the hat to weave in the last ch-4 and hide loose end.



20. Fasten off extra thread.

This clip will stay in one piece forever, it is held together better that any glue would make it.





Find the purple flower pattern below.









2. Rnd 1: 12 dc into 1st ch. Join rnd with sl st.



3. Rnd 2: Ch 2, 2 dc in 1st dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2, sl st into same st as last dc. First petal complete.



4. * sl st into next dc, ch 2, 2 dc in same st as sl st, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2, sl st in same dc as last dc. Repeat from * 4 times. The flower now has 6 petals. Fasten off.



5. Ch 3, dc in 1st ch, ch 2, sl st in same ch as dc.



6. *Ch 2, dc into 1st ch of the flower, ch 2, sl st into 1st ch of the flower. Repeat from * 3 more times. 5 petals total.



7. Fasten off leaving long end



8. Sew smaller flower onto the bigger one as shown. Use long yarn end to sew flower onto the hair clip. Fasten off and weave in all ends.
