

Washing with the King of the Jungle

The jungle can be a messy place, but your kids will beg for the king of beasts to help clean them up. Thankfully, with easy knit and purl stitches and instructions offered in written and charted form, you'll whip this quick knit up in no time at all!

This pattern includes instructions for both versions, in both written and charted form.



YARN REQUIREMENTS

Approximately 140 yds of 100% cotton worsted weight yarn.

Shown in Knit Picks *Simply Cotton Organic Worsted*, colorway Toffee and knit on size US 7 (4.5mm) needles and Lily *Sugar 'n Cream*, colorway 00026 blue and knit on size US 8 (5.0mm) needles.

MATERIALS AND NOTIONS

One pair US size 7 (4.5mm) needles, or size needed to obtain desired fabric
Tapestry needle

GAUGE

Getting gauge isn't terribly important but will determine the finished size of your washcloth. Using needles sized US 6 (4.0mm) – US 8 (5.0mm) will likely yield a cloth approximately 8"-10" wide x 7"-9" tall.

TECHNIQUES USED

Long-tail cast on, knit and purl stitches.

ABBREVIATIONS and SYMBOLS

• p on RS, k on WS

RS right side

WS wrong side

INSTRUCTIONS – Full mane version

Cast on 44, using long-tail method.

Follow written instructions for each row or use the chart on the next page.

Rows 1 and 3 (RS): *K1, p1; repeat from * to end.

Rows 2 and 4: *P1, k1; repeat from * to end.

Row 5: (K1, p1) twice, k36, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 6: (P1, k1) twice, p11, k4, p3, k4, p14, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 7: (K1, p1) twice, k12, p3, k2, p2, k1, p2, k2, p3, k9, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 8: (P1, k1) twice, p9, k1, p1, k1, p2, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p2, k1, p1, k1, p12, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 9: (K1, p1) twice, k11, p2, k6, p1, k6, p2, k8, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 10: (P1, k1) twice, p6, k2, p1, (k1, p6) twice, k1, p1, k1, p10, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 11: (K1, p1) twice, k8, p2, k2, (p1, k6) twice, p1, k3, p1, k5, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 12: (P1, k1) twice, p5, k1, p4, k2, p4, k1, p4, k2, p3, k1, p1, k1, p7, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 13: (K1, p1) twice, k6, p1, k2, (p1, k4) three times, (p1, k5) twice, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 14: (P1, k1) twice, (p5, k1) twice, (p4, k1) three times, p2, k1, p6, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 15: (K1, p1) twice, k5, p1, k2, p2, (k4, p1) three times, k6, p1, k4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 16: (P1, k1) twice, p4, k1, p6, (k1, p4) three times, k1, p1, k1, p2, k1, p4, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 17: (K1, p1) twice, k4, p1, k1, p1, k2, p1, k4, p1, k3, p3, k3, p1, k6, p1, k4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 18: (P1, k1) twice, p5, k1, p20, k1, p3, k2, p4, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 19: (K1, p1) twice, k4, p2, k3, p1, k4, p1, (k1, p2) twice, (k1, p1) twice, k5, p1, k5, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 20: (P1, k1) twice, p6, k3, p2, k11, p1, k3, p4, k2, p4, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 21: (K1, p1) twice, k3, p4, k5, p16, k8, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 22: (P1, k1) twice, p6, k1, p1, k16, p1, k1, p3, k4, p3, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 23: (K1, p1) twice, k3, p4, k3, p20, k6, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 24: (P1, k1) twice, p6, k9, p2, k9, p3, k4, p3, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 25: (K1, p1) twice, k4, p2, k4, p6, k8, p6, k1, p1, k4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 26: (P1, k1) twice, p4, k7, p11, k6, p8, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 27: (K1, p1) twice, k8, p5, k13, p6, k4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 28: (P1, k1) twice, p4, k5, p4, k3, p1, k3, p3, k6, p7, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 29: (K1, p1) twice, k8, p4, (k3, p1) three times, k4, p5, k3, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 30: (P1, k1) twice, p3, k5, p7, k3, p6, k5, p7, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 31: (K1, p1) twice, k7, p5, k5, p1, k3, p1, k6, p4, k4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 32: (P1, k1) twice, p5, k5, p5, k3, p6, k5, p7, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 33: (K1, p1) twice, k8, p5, k5, p3, k5, p7, k3, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 34: (P1, k1) twice, p4, k7, p5, k1, p5, k7, p7, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 35: (K1, p1) twice, k7, p8, k10, p6, k5, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 36: (P1, k1) twice, p5, k7, p2, k2, p1, k2, p2, k7, p8, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 37: (K1, p1) twice, k7, p7, k3, p2, k1, p2, k4, p6, k4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 38: (P1, k1) twice, p5, k4, p3, k1, p10, k5, p8, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 39: (K1, p1) twice, k9, p4, k3, p2, (k3, p3) twice, k6, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 40: (P1, k1) twice, p5, k22, p9, (p1, k1) twice.



Row 41: (K1, p1) twice, k10, p22, k4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 42: (P1, k1) twice, p8, k18, p10, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 43: (K1, p1) twice, k13, p16, k7, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 44: (P1, k1) twice, p9, k2, p1, k5, p1, k2, p1, k2, p13, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 45: (K1, p1) twice, k13, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k1, p2, k12, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 46: (P1, k1) twice, p12, k1, p2, k1, p4, k1, p15, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 47: (K1, p1) twice, k36, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 48: (P1, k1) twice, p36, (p1, k1) twice.

Rows 49 and 51: *K1, p1; repeat from * to end.

Rows 50 and 52: *P1, k1; repeat from * to end.

Bind off and weave in ends.

INSTRUCTIONS – Outlined mane version

Cast on 44, using long-tail method.

Follow written instructions for each row or use the chart on the next page.

Rows 1 and 3 (RS): *K1, p1; repeat from * to end.

Rows 2 and 4: *P1, k1; repeat from * to end.

Row 5: (K1, p1) twice, k36, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 6: (P1, k1) twice, p11, k4, p3, k4, p14, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 7: (K1, p1) twice, k12, p3, k2, p2, k1, p2, k2, p3, k9, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 8: (P1, k1) twice, p9, k1, p1, k1, p2, (k1, p1) twice, k1, p2, k1, p1, k1, p12, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 9: (K1, p1) twice, k11, p2, k6, p1, k6, p2, k8, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 10: (P1, k1) twice, p6, k2, p1, (k1, p6) twice, k1, p1, k1, p10, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 11: (K1, p1) twice, k8, p2, k2, (p1, k6) twice, p1, k3, p1, k5, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 12: (P1, k1) twice, p5, k1, p4, k2, p4, k1, p4, k2, p3, k1, p1, k1, p7, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 13: (K1, p1) twice, k6, p1, k2, (p1, k4) three times, (p1, k5) twice, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 14: (P1, k1) twice, (p5, k1) twice, (p4, k1) three times, p2, k1, p6, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 15: (K1, p1) twice, k5, p1, k2, p2, (k4, p1) three times, k6, p1, k4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 16: (P1, k1) twice, p4, k1, p6, (k1, p4) three times, k1, p1, k1, p2, k1, p4, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 17: (K1, p1) twice, k4, p1, k1, p1, k2, p1, k4, p1, k3, p3, k3, p1, k6, p1, k4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 18: (P1, k1) twice, p5, k1, p20, k1, p3, k2, p4, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 19: (K1, p1) twice, k4, p2, k3, p1, k6, p2, k1, p1, k1, p2, k7, p1, k5, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 20: (P1, k1) twice, p6, k3, p2, k2, p2, k1, p1, k1, p2, k2, p1, k3, p4, k2, p4, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 21: (K1, p1) twice, k3, p4, k5, p1, k10, p4, k9, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 22: (P1, k1) twice, p6, k1, p1, k1, p14, k1, p5, k4, p3, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 23: (K1, p1) twice, k3, p4, k3, p2, k7, p2, k6, p3, k6 (k1, p1) twice.

Row 24: (P1, k1) twice, p6, k1, p5, k3, p2, k3, p5, k1, p3, k4, p3 (p1, k1) twice.

Row 25: (K1, p1) twice, k4, p2, k4, p1, k3, p2, k8, p1, k4, p1, k1, p1, k4 (k1, p1) twice.

Row 26: (P1, k1) twice, p4, k2, p4, k1, p11, k1, p3, k2, p8, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 27: (K1, p1) twice, k8, p1, k3, p1, k13, (p1, k4) twice, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 28: (P1, k1) twice, p4, k1, p3, k1, p4, k3, p1, k3, p3, k1, p4, k1, p7, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 29: (K1, p1) twice, k8, p1, k2, (p1, k3) four times, p1, k4, p1, k3, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 30: (P1, k1) twice, p3, k1, p4, k1, p6, k3, p6, k1, p3, k1, p7, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 31: (K1, p1) twice, k7, p1, k3, p1, k5, p1, k3, p1, k5, p1, k3, p1, k4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 32: (P1, k1) twice, p5, k1, p2, k1, p6, k3, p6, k1, p3, k1, p7, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 33: (K1, p1) twice, k8, p1, k3, p1, k5, p3, k5, p1, k3, p3, k3, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 34: (P1, k1) twice, p4, k1, (p5, k1) four times, p7, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 35: (K1, p1) twice, k7, p1, k6, p1, k10, p1, k4, p1, k5, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 36: (P1, k1) twice, p5, k1, p4, k1, p3, k2, p1, k2, p2, k1, p5, k1, p8, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 37: (K1, p1) twice, k7, p1, k5, p1, k3, p2, k1, p2, k4, (p1, k4) twice, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 38: (P1, k1) twice, p5, k1, p2, k1, p14, k1, p3, k1, p8, (p1, k1) twice.



Row 39: (K1, p1) twice, k9, p1, k2, p1, k3, p2, k4, p2, k3, p1, k1, p1, k6, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 40: (P1, k1) twice, p5, k1, p3, k3, p2, k4, p2, k3, p3, k1, p9, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 41: (K1, p1) twice, k10, p1, k16, p5, k4, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 42: (P1, k1) twice, p8, k1, p13, k4, p10, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 43: (K1, p1) twice, k13, p1, k1, p2, k1, p2, k4, p1, k2, p2, k7, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 44: (P1, k1) twice, p9, k2, p1, k1, p1, k3, p1, k2, p1, k2, p13, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 45: (K1, p1) twice, k13, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k1, p2, k12, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 46: (P1, k1) twice, p12, k1, p2, k1, p4, k1, p15, (p1, k1) twice.

Row 47: (K1, p1) twice, k36, (k1, p1) twice.

Row 48: (P1, k1) twice, p36, (p1, k1) twice.

Rows 49 and 51: *K1, p1; repeat from * to end.

Rows 50 and 52: *P1, k1; repeat from * to end.

Bind off and weave in ends.
