

## **Mini Homespun Wizard Hat**

This was my first attempt at making a miniature Santa hat Christmas ornament. As you can see, it didn't turn out so well as a Santa hat, but it's great as a wizard's! No gauge needed. Just use whatever yarn you want and whichever needles feel right to you.



CO24. K across, distributing sts evenly on three needles (if using circulars, disregard the last part ~ just K across). Join in the round and knit 5 rows.

Row 7: K4, k2tog around.

Rows 8 & 9: K around.

Row 10: K3, k2tog around.

Rows 11 & 12: K around.

Row 13: K2, k2tog around.

Rows 14 & 15: K around.

Row 16: K1, k2tog around.

Rows 17 & 18: K around.

Row 19: K2tog around.

Rows 20 & 21: K around.

Break yarn, leaving 6" tail, and sew through all loops. Pull up tight and tie off. Tie end of tail through top of hat for hanging loop. Weave in ends.
