Mini Homespun Christmas Mitten

No gauge needed. Just use whatever yarn you have and whichever needles feel right to you.



Pattern notes:

KRL = Knit Right Loop increase KLL = Knit Left Loop increase

To see how to do these, go to KnittingHelp.com's increases page. Brackets [] mean work all sts between brackets for specified amount. For instance, [K1, p1] twice = K1, p1, k1, p1.

CO 24, leaving long tail for hanging loop. Divide onto three needles, 8 sts on each one (disregard this if using circular needles). Join to work in round and work k1p1 rib for 8 rounds, then k one round.

Thumb opening:

First needle: K all 8 sts.

Second needle: K3, pm, KRL, k2, KLL, pm, k3.

Third needle: K all 8 sts.

(If using circular needles, knit all three above lines as one round.)

*K one round. Knit next round, increasing as above just after the first marker and again just before the second marker. Repeat from * until 10 sts are between markers.

K one round.

K to first marker, remove it, k1, place next 8 sts on stitch holder or scrap yarn, k to end of round, joining hand sides back together above thumb opening in the process (by knitting straight across as if the stitches on the stitch holder weren't there).

Continue with hand:

K 6 rounds.

Fingertip decrease:

[K2, k2tog] around (6 sts on each needle).

K around.

K2tog around (4 sts on each needle).

K around.

K2tog around (2 sts on each needle).

Cut yarn and draw through remaining sts, pulling tight and tying off.

Thumb: Place thumb sts from stitch holder to 2 needles (if using circulars, place on one set of circulars for magic loop). K two rounds. [K2, k2tog] twice (3 sts on each needle). Cut yarn and

draw through all remaining sts, pulling up tight and tying off. Make hanging loop from cast on tail by making a 6 st crochet chain. Tie off. Weave in ends.
