## **TWO SIDES DISHCLOTH**

This dishcloth is reversible and has two different sides!  
One side has a knobby texture and the other shows the slipped stitches.  
Knit on the bias, this dishcloth grows quickly to any size and there are no purls!



### **Gauge**

Not crucial, dishcloth is worked on the bias and size is adjustable

### **Yarn / Hook**

Any 100% cotton yarn and a suitable hook

### **Abbreviations (US terminology):**

k = knit

wyb = with yarn in back

Kfb = knit in front and back

K2togtbl = knit 2 sts together through back loop

k3togtbl = knit 3 together through back loop

sts = stitches

slip all sts purlwise

## **PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS**

### **Set-up**

Cast on 2 sts

**Row 1:** Kfb, K to end

Repeat Row 1 until you have 6 sts

### **Increase part**

**Row 1:** Kfb, K1, slip 1 wyb, K3

**Row 2:** Kfb, K to end

**Row 3:** Kfb, slip 1 wyb, \*K1, slip 1 wyb, repeat from \* to last 2 sts, K2

**Row 4:** Kfb, K to end

**Row 5:** Kfb, K1, \*slip 1 wyb, K1, repeat from \* to last 2 sts, K2

**Row 6:** Kfb, K to end

**Row 7:** Kfb, slip 1 wyb, \*K1, slip 1 wyb, repeat from \* to last 2 sts, K2

Repeat last 4 rows until you have reached your desired size, end with Row 7.

### **Decrease part**

**Row 1:** K2togtbl, K to end

**Row 2:** K2togtbl, slip 1 wyb, \*K1, slip 1 wyb, repeat from \* to last 3 sts, K3

**Row 3:** K2togtbl, K to end

**Row 4:** K2togtbl, K1, \*slip 1 wyb, K1, repeat from \* to last 3 sts, slip 1 wyb, K2

Repeat last 4 rows until you have 6 sts left

**Next Row:** K2togtbl, K to end

Repeat this Row until you have 3 sts left

**Last Row:** k3togtbl

Fasten off and weave in any loose ends. Your dishcloth will look more like a diamond than a square – you'll need to block it into the shape of a square.
