THE YARN ADVENTURER PROUDLY PRESENTS...

FLIP IT DISHCLOTH

Let's flip it! First, you knit two triangles -then you flip one to the wrong side!

Graft both triangles together and you have a dishcloth displaying both right side and wrong side at the same time!

A slip stitch pattern shows columns of slipped stitches on one side and little blocks on the other side.





Gauge

Not crucial, dishcloth consists of two triangles that can be worked to any size

Yarn / Knitting needle

Any 100% cotton yarn and 2 suitable knitting needles of the same size

Abbreviations (US terminology):

K = knit

P = Purl

wyb = with yarn in back

wyf = with yarn in front

Kfb = knit in front and back

sts = stitches

slip all sts purlwise

RS = Right Side

WS = Wrong Side

PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

Triangle

Cast on 2 sts

Row 1: Kfb, K to end

Repeat Row 1 until you have 7 sts

Slip Stitch pattern

Row 1: Kfb, P2, slip 1 wyb, P2, K1

Row 2: Kfb, K2, slip 1 wyf, K4

Row 3: Kfb, K to end

Row 4: Kfb, P to last 2 sts, K2

Row 5: Kfb, P1, *slip 1 wyb, P2, repeat from *

to last 3 sts, slip 1 wyb, P1, K1

Row 6: Kfb, K1, slip 1 wyf, K2, repeat from * to

last stitch, K1

Row 7: repeat Row 3

Row 8: repeat Row 4

Row 9: Kfb, *slip 1 wyb, P2, repeat from * to

last 2 sts, slip 1 wyb, K1

Row 10: Kfb, *slip 1 wyf, K2, repeat from * to

end

Row 11: repeat Row 3

Row 12: repeat Row 4

Row 13: Kfb, P2, *slip 1 wyb, P2, repeat from *

to last stitch, K1

Row 14: Kfb, K2, *slip 1 wyf, K2, repeat from *

to last 2 sts, K2


Row 15: repeat Row 3

Row 16: repeat Row 4

Repeat Row 5 - Row 16 until you have reached

your desired size, end with a RS Row.

Last Row (WS): Kfb, K all sts



Fasten off first triangle. Knit another triangle of

the same size on your second knitting needle.



Kitchener Stitch for Garter Stitch Photo Tutorial

Hold both set of live stitches parallel (second triangle is at the back with yarn on the right, first triangle is at the front). Make sure that the RS of first triangle is facing you. After grafting all sts together, fasten off and weave in any loose ends. Block if desired.



Step 1
bring yarn around the front (under the knitting needles). Insert needle knitwise into first stitch (front), slip stitch off



Step 2 insert needle purlwise into next stitch (front), leave on knitting needle



Step 3 insert needle knitwise into first stitch (back), slip stitch off



Step 4 insert needle purlwise into next stitch (back), leave on knitting needle
