# **DANCING DOTS** DISHCLOTH

This is Dishcloth No1 of the Double Fun Dishcloth KAL!

Made entirely in garter stitch, this dishcloth has a great texture. The slipped stitches result in little dots that seem to dance around each other.



#### Size

Adjustable

### Yarn / Knitting needle

Any cotton yarn and a suitable knitting needle

You should use two contrasting solid colors

## Abbreviations (US terminology):

K = Knit

wyb = with yarn in back

slip all sts purlwise

sts = stitches

RS = Right Side

WS = Wrong Side

C1 = Color 1

C2 = Color 2

#### PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS

C1 = Light Color

C2 = Dark Color

Every color is worked for 2 rows.

Carry the unused color up the side by twisting the two strands when you change color.

With C1, cast on on a multiple of 3 + 4

Row 1 (RS): C1, K all sts

Row 2 (WS): C1, K all sts

to last 2 sts, K2

Row 4 (WS): C1, K all sts

**Row 5 (RS):** C2, K2, (K2, slip 1 wyb), repeat ( )

to last 2 sts, K2

Row 6 (WS): C2, K all sts

Repeat Row 3 - Row 6 until you have almost reached your desired size --- end with Row 4!

Fasten off C1. Change to C2.

Next Row (RS): K all sts Next Row (WS): K all sts

Repeat last 2 rows once more

Row 3 (RS): C1, K2, (slip 1 wyb, K2), repeat ( ) You can use any not too stretchy bind-off of

your choice.

I used the Chain Bind-off:

K1, (K1, insert left needle into first stitch on right needle and pass stitch over second), repeat the steps in ( ) to end of row

Fasten off and weave in any loose ends. If desired, block your dishcloth.
