knits in

FAIRY STAR CHAIR MAT



a *tiny owl knits* pattern

This sweet chair mat has 7 points. Just like a fairy star!

Owl meter: beginner----advanced

Owl level:

Measurements: 14 inches in diameter

Yarns used: Super bulky wool such as: Debbie Bliss Como 50 g - 46 yds -42 m, 90% wool 10% cashmere, Soft grey, Color No 19003, No. of balls: 2

Tension/gauge:

Work 10 sts to measure 4" in St stitch using US 15 (10 mm) needles and super bulky wool.

Notions:

A pair of US 15 (10 mm) circular needles 16" long A set of US 15 (10 mm) dpns tapestry needle, stitch marker, size P crochet hook

Tiny owl stitch dictionary:

ch: chain k: knit **k2tog:** knit the next two stitches together sc: single crochet ss: slip stitch

Pattern notes:

The fairy star chair mat is double sided. You'll make two mats and use double crochet to secure them together. You could stuff the mat if you want to make a pillow.

🕅 Ready? Let's go!

With size 15 circular needles, cast on 84 stitches, join in the round & place marker (*switch to dpns when necessary*.)

Round 1: *knit 10, k2tog, repeat from * Round 2: *knit 9, k2tog, repeat from *

Round 3: *knit 8, k2tog, repeat from *

Round 4: *knit 7, k2tog, repeat from *

Round 5: *knit 6, k2tog, repeat from *

Round 6: *knit 5, k2tog, repeat from *

Round 7: *knit 4, k2tog, repeat from *

Round 8: *knit 3, k2tog, repeat from *

Round 9: *knit 2, k2tog, repeat from *

Round 10: *knit 1, k2tog, repeat from *

Round 11: *k2tog repeat from *

Thread yarn through live sts, break yarn & weave ends.

Make two.

Seaming:

Put stars together pretty side out, line up the points and pin together around the edges to prepare for seaming. With P crochet hook, attach yarn at a flat edge and ch2.

Round 1:

Work dc into each stitch around the mat. (Go through both mats to join the two pieces of fabric together.) Meanwhile, when you get to each of the 7 points, work 2dc in them to turn the corners. Finish with ss into 1st ch2.

Note:

If you want to make a pillow, leave space to stuff it with polyester stuffing before you crochet all the way around.

🕍 Optional ties: Make 2

(Not pictured cause I have naughty cats) ^.. ^~~~~ With crochet hook, chain 15, break yarn & weave ends. Attach center of chain in a V to two points of the mat.
