



HUP HOLLAND



Size: Small (medium, large)
Hat circumference: 48 (50, 52) cm,

Yarn suggestion: Dalegarn Falk (sport)

Needles: Circular needles 2,5 (3,0, 3,5) mm and circular needles and dpns 3,0 (3,5, 4,0 mm) dpn's 3,5 mm, or needles to get gauge (US 4).
Gauge: 25 (24,23) m per 10 cm

Colours: Orange, black, blue, white, red. (You need less than one skein of orange and black, and just a little bit of the other colours.)



Abbreviations

CO	cast on
dpn	double pointed needle
k	knit
k2tog (/)	knit two together
m1	make one stitch
p	purl
sk2psso (^)	slip 1 stitch, k2tog, pass slipped stitch over
ssk (\)	slip 2 stitches as if to knit, then return to left needle and knit together through back loops
st(s)	stitch(es)

CO 96 with blue yarn on smaller needles. Join in the round. K 2 rounds, p 6 (7,8) rounds. Change to white: K 2 rounds, p 4 (5,6) rounds. Change to red: K 2 rounds, p 4 (5,6) rounds.

Change to orange. The rest of the hat is worked in stockinette stitch and stranded colourwork.

K 1 round. On next round: *k 4, m1* repeat from * to *. (= 120 sts).

K 0 (2,4) rounds with orange. Then start working according to chart. Chart is worked from right to left, and from bottom to top. Decrease according to chart. Change to dpns when hat is too small for circular needles.



When chart is done, you have 52 sts.
Move the first 26 sts onto one needle,
the last 26 onto another. Graft together
using kitchener stitch. (If you're not
familiar with that, you can find several
online tutorials, or you can bind off and
sew the hat together.)



Weave in ends. Wash and block if needed.

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
