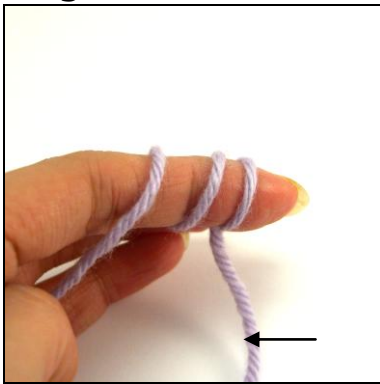
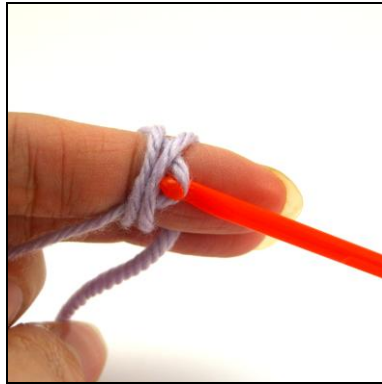


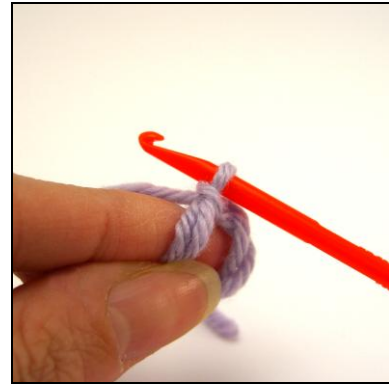
Magic Circle:



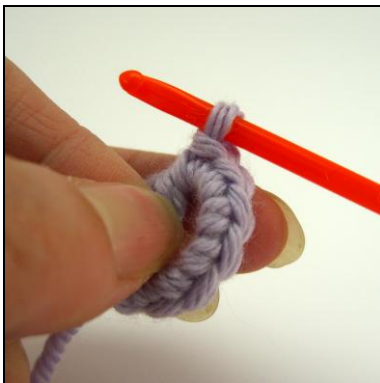
Wrap yarn around finger 3 times. Tail should be on the right.



Use hook to grab the yarn furthest to the left from below (closest to the ball).



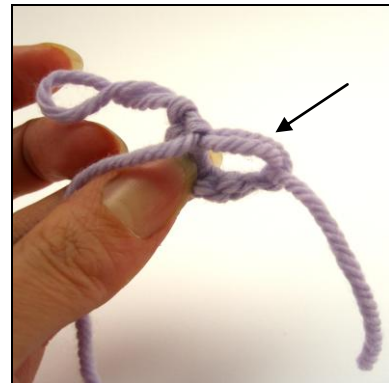
Use the loop pulled thru to slip stitch (you'll need to take your finger out).



Now do your 6 single crochets (or what the pattern asks for) by going into the large loop.



Pull out the last loop you make so it sticks out (just so it won't get lost).



Now look for the part of the big loop that has 2 strands.



Tug on one of these 2 strands. One should act to close the large loop. Pull on this to close the loop.



Then pull on the loose tail until the loop closes completely. Put hook back in your last sc that you made stick out, and tighten it back up to continue with your pattern.



Count your stitches to make sure you have 6 stitches visible. The first stitch may be a little hard to see. You should be going under 2 strands for your next stitch as usual.
