Materials

Material Coats Knit-cro sheen

Size 2 : 3 balls of white, ecru or cream

Size 4: 3 balls of white, ecru or cream or 5 balls of any color

(in the 1940's colors had less on the ball than white, ecru, and cream now you would buy the same amount of both)

Steel crochet hook No. 7 5 buttons 2 yards narrow velvet ribbon

Finished Measurements:

Sizes	2	4	=		
Length from shoulder to bottom of skirt 16" 17 1/2"					
width of hem	45"	48"			

It was the style in the 1940's to wear bloomers and girls would wear very short dresses to show off their bloomers. If you want a longer dress make more repeats in the skirt for length and buy more balls of thread in the beginning so you have the same dye lot.

GAUGE: 4 sps measure 1 inch; 4 rows measure 1 inch

BODICE...

Starting at bottom, make a chain to measure about

sizes	2	4

2**4" 26"**

(12 chains to an inch).

1st row: Dc in 8th chain from hook,* ch2, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch. Repeat from * across until there have been made

90sps 96 sps cut off remaining chain.

Because of the way chains work in that they only unravel one direction this is not a problem. This is an old fashioned way of starting a project so you don't have to count chains.

Ch 3, turn

2nd row: Make dc in each dc and 2 dc in each sp across, counting turning ch as 1 dc. Ch 5, turn.

3rd row: Skip 2 dc,* dc in next dc, ch 2, skip 2 dc. Repeat from *across, dc in top st of turning ch. Ch 3, turn. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows alternately for 2 inches, ending with 3rd row.

LEFT BACK...

Work in pattern across next

19 sps 20 sps

Ch 3, turn. Continue working in pattern over these sts only until piece measures in all, ending with 2nd row of pattern,

6" 6 1/2 "

Fasten off.

Attach thread and work a similar piece at opposite end of Bodice for Right Back.

FRONT...

Attach thread and work in pattern across the center

38 sps 40sps until piece measures, ending with 2nd row of pattern,

sizes	2	4
	4''	4 1/2 "

Next Row: Work in pattern over these sts only for shoulder until piece measures in all, ending with 2nd row of pattern,

6" 6 1/2"

Fasten off.

Attach thread and work other shoulder to correspond.

SKIRT...

1st rnd:With right side facing, attach thread in 1st sp at lower edge of BODICE, ch 5, * in next sp on foundation chain make (dc, ch 2) twice; dc in next dc, ch 5, dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in next sp, ch 2, in next sp make (dc, ch2) twice; dc in next sp, ch 2, dc in next dc, ch 5, dc in next dc, ch 5, dc in next dc, ch 5, dc in next dc, ch 2. Repeat from * across, ending with ch 5, sl st in 3rd st of turning ch at beginning of rnd (hereafter skirt is worked in rounds).

2nd rnd: Ch 3, * (2 dc in next sp, dc in next dc) 3 times; ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 2, (dc in next dc, ch 2) 5 times; dc in next dc, ch 2, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 2, dc in next dc. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 2, sc in last ch-5 sp, ch 2, sl st in top st of starting chain.

3rd rnd: Ch 5,* (skip 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 2) twice; dc in next dc, ch 5, (dc in next dc, ch 2) 5 times; dc in next dc, ch 5, dc in next dc, ch 2. Repeat from * around, ending with ch 5, sl st in center st of starting chain. Repeat 2nd and 3rd rnds alternately until Skirt measures

10" 11"

Fasten off.

This previous section is where you would lengthen the dress to for modern lengths and modesty. Measure from 2 inches below arm to the position on the leg you want the dress hem to hit. This is the

measurement you use instead on the ones listed on the previous page for the skirt length.

sizes 2 4

SLEEVES...

Starting at bottom, make a chain to measure about 11 inches. Work in pattern as on **BODICE**, having on 1st row

36 sps 40sps

Cut off remaining chain.

Continue working in pattern for 2 inches, ending with 3rd row of pattern.

To shape top:

Sl st across 6 st at beginning of next

12 row 14 rows

Fasten off.

ASSEMBLY:

Sew shoulder seams. Work a row of sc along **LEFT BACK** opening; work 5 ch-5 loops evenly along **RIGHT BACK** opening.

Work beading at neck as follows: ch 5, * skip 2 sts, dc in next st, ch 2. Repeat last st. Fasten off.

Sew up sleeves seams and sew sleeves in, shirring extra fullness in top 3 inches at shoulder.

Sew on buttons.

Press through damp cloth.

Run velvet ribbon through neck beading and through the row of sps at bottom of **BODICE**.
