

LONG BROCADE SCARF

Unyewshual

A fashionably long and narrow scarf. The stitch pattern comes from volume three of a 1980's English knitting series called Creative Knitting. No details of the publisher are available in this edition.



MATERIALS

Celone by Heirloom, 50g balls, each approx 100m(109 yds) (Merino, Alpaca, Silk) or any other DK, Light Worsted or 8ply yarn, perhaps with a little silk.

- 5 balls
- One pair size 4mm needles OR size to obtain gauge

MEASUREMENTS

15cm(6 in) x 182.5cm(72 in)

GAUGE

21sts and 32 rows to 10cm(4 ins) over stitch pattern using 4mm needles

STITCH PATTERN

Row 1 (WS) p4, k6, p4
Row 2 knit
Row 3 and 4 As rows 1 and 2
Row 5 As row 1
Row 6 k3, p1, k6, p1, k3
Row 7 p2, k1, p8, k1, p2
Row 8 k1, p1, k10, p1, k1
Row 9 k1, p12, k1
Row 10 As row 8
Row 11 As row 7
Row 12 As row 6

SCARF

Cast on 34 sts
Work in k1, p1 rib for 6cm(2.5 ins) ending with a RS row

For the body of the scarf, maintain a 3st border on either side as foll:

WS rows sl1, p1, k1, work patt to last 3 sts, k1, p2
RS rows sl1, k1, p1, work patt to last 3 sts, p1, k2

Work stitch pattern until piece measures around 176.5cm(69.5 in) ending with row 5 of pattern.
Work in k1, p1 rib for 6cm(2.5 in)
Cast/bind off in rib.
