

# *cabled mittens*

## **Cabled mittens**



These mittens are knitted top down. The thumb is knitted separately and then added to the body with constantly decreases forming the gusset. The cables on the lefthand and righthand mitten run in opposite directions, coming together to a symmetrical pattern.

### **Size**

Length = 9.45'' or 24 cm

Circumference = 7.5'' or 19 cm

### **Material**

100 Gramm Schachenmayer Extra Merino Big (100% Schurwolle) or any other quality to obtain gauge,

5 doublepointed needles Nr. 4,5 (US 6)

5 doublepointed needles Nr. 4 (US 7)

1 cable needle

1 tapestry needle

### **Abbreviations**

CN = cable needle

rd = round

st = stitch

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k = knit

p = purl

s = slip

p1 f&b = (increase) purl into the front and back of 1 stitch

p1 b&f = (increase) purl into the back and front of 1 stitch

p1f k1b = (increase) purl into the front and knit into the back of 1 stitch

k1 f&b = (increase) knit into the front and back of 1 stitch

tog. = together

p2 tog = (decrease) purl 2 sts together

p2 btog = (decrease) purl into back from the 2. stitch and purl 2 stitches together

## **Pattern**

Working in reversed stockinette stitch, purling each round.

## **Cables**

Work the cables following the charts paying attention to the fact that the pattern for the lefthand and the righthand mitten is different.

## **rdibbing:**

k2, p2

## **Gauge:**

16 st and 24 rows (in stockinette stitch) =  
4'' or 10 x 10 cm

## **Thumb:**

CO 4 st and work with 2 double-pointed needles 4.5 at first.

**rd 1:** Join to the round, (p1 f&b) 4 times = 8 sts.

**rd 2:** (p1 f&b) 3 times, p1, (p1 f&b) 3 times, p1 = 14 sts (distribute to 3 needles)

**rd 3-14:** p14 , place 14 sts onto scrap yarn

## **Mitten** (starting with the right-hand)

CO 4 st and work with 2 double-pointed needles 4.5 at first (2 st per needle).

**rd 1:** Join to the round, p4.

**rd 2:** p1 f&b, p1 b&f, p1 f&b, p1 b&f = 8 sts

**rd 3:** p1 f&b, k1, k1 f&b, p1 (6 sts on needle 1), p1 f&b, p2, p1 b&f (6 sts on needle 2) = 12 sts

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**rd 4:** p1f k1b, k3, k1 f&b, p1 (8 sts on needle 1), p1 f&b, p4, p1 b&f (8 sts on needle 2) = 16 sts

**rd 5:** p1f k1b, k5, k1 f&b, p1 (10 sts on needle 1), p1 f&b, p6, p1 b&f (10 sts on needle 2) = 20 sts

**rd 6:** k1 f&b , k7, k1 f&b, p1 (12 sts on needle 1), p1 f&b, p8, 1mal p1 b&f (12 sts on needle 2) = 24 sts.  
Distribute sts to 4 needles (= 6 sts per needle)

**rd 7:** p1f k1b, k9, k1 f&b, p1, p1 f&b, p10, p1 b&f = 28 sts

**rd 8:** p1f k1b, k11, k1 f&b, p1, p1 f&b, p12, p1 b&f = 32 sts

**rd 9:** Knit or purl as sts appear.

**rd 10:** p1f k1b, k13, k1 f&b, p1, p1 f&b., p14, p1 b&f = 36 sts

**rd 11:** Knit or purl as sts appear.

**rd 12:** p1f k1b, k15, k1 f&b, p1, p1 f&b, p16, p1 b&f = 40 sts

**rd 13:** St 1 to 20: follow the instruction of the chart knitting the right pattern for the right hand mitten and the left pattern for the left hand mitten, p20

**rd 14 to 20:** St 1 to 20: follow the instruction of the chart, p20

**rd 21:** Join the sts of the thumb to the body.  
right hand mitten: St 1 to 20: follow the instruction of the chart, p20, p14 sts of the thumb (adding 7 sts to needle 4 and 7 sts to needle 1). PM to the 8. st of the thumb. This will be the 1. st of all following rds.  
Left hand mitten: st 1 to 20: follow the instruction of the chart, p14 sts of the thumb (adding 7 sts to needle 2 and 7 sts to needle 3), p20.

**rd 22:** p6, p2 tog, st 2 to 20 following the chart, p19, p2 btog, p6

**rd 23:** p5, p2 tog, st 2 to 20 following the chart, p19, p2 btog, p5

**rd 24:** p4, p2 tog, st 2 to 20 following the chart, p19, p2 btog, p4

**rd 25:** p3, p2tog, st 2 to 20 following the chart, p19, p2 btog, p3

**rd 26:** p2, p2tog, st 2 to 20 following the chart, p19, p2 btog, p2

**rd 27:** p1, p2tog, st 2 to 20 following the chart, p19, p2 btog, p1

**rd 28:** p2tog, st 2 to 20 following the chart, p19, p2 btog = 40 sts.  
For the left hand mitten the decreases for the thumb are done symmetrically on the other side.

**rd 29 to 41:** st 1 to 20 following the chart, p20.

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**rd 42 bis 53:** r-dibbing with needle Nr. 4: (k2 p2) 10 times

**rd 54:** Bind off all stitches.

**Finishing:** Weave in loose ends, block and enjoy.


Repeat rd 1 to 16 regularly.

sl6 to CN, hold in back, k6, k6 from CN
