Boater Bob Inspired Ribbed Hat

Needles

1 pair of 4mm (US6) double pointed (or size needed to get gauge) 1 pair of 3.25mm (US3) double pointed

Yarn

Sublime baby cashmere merino silk dk (or other DK yarn with good stitch definition)

Sizes

0-6 mos (6-12 mos, 12-18 mos)

Abbreviations

k2tog – knit 2 together p2tog – purl 2 together

Gauge

4-inch square using 4mm (US6) 22 stitches/28 rows in stockinette

Using smaller needles, cast on 70 (78, 84) stitches. Join to work in the round and place marker.

For all sizes

Knit 1x1 rib (k1, p1) for four rows Knit 3 rows in stockinette.

For 0-6 mos and 12-18 mos only

Knit 1 row in stockinette.

For 6-12 mos only

Knit to last 2 stitches before marker, knit these 2 stitches together (you now have 77 stitches).

Change to larger needles and work 4x3 rib (k4, p3) for 3(3.5, 3.75) inches (should have $\sim 4(4.5, 4.75)$ inches from edge).

Crown Shaping

*k2tog, k2, p3, repeat around from * - you now have 60 (66, 72) stitches.

*k3, p3, repeat around from *.

Repeat this last row 2 more times.

*k3, p2tog, p1, repeat around from * - you now have 50 (55, 60) stitches.

*k3, p2, repeat around from *.

*k2tog, k1, p2, repeat around from * - you now have 40 (44, 48) stitches.

*k2, p2, repeat around from *.

*k2, p2tog, repeat around from * - you now have 30 (33, 36) stitches.

*k2, p1, repeat around from *.

*k2tog, p1, repeat around from * - you now have 20 (22, 24) stitches.

*k1, p1, repeat around from *.

*k2tog, repeat around from * - you now have 10 (11, 12) stitches.

Cut yarn and thread through remaining 10 (11, 12) stitches and pull tight to close hole. Weave in ends.
