## Riddiculously quick crochet shrug



You've been looking for that really quick pattern? To make that small gift, use that lonely skein, or just to get some instant satisfaction?
I'm right, right?
Of course I am! ^^^
The shrug is worked sideways from tie to tie, edging and all at once!

## Sizes:

3 months
(chest: 16 inches/40 cm)
6 months
(chest: 17 inches/43 cm)
12 months
(chest: 18 inches $/ 45 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
24 months
(chest: 20 inches $/ 50 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Gauge:

4 dc and 2 rows/inch.

## Materials:

Appr 75/100/130/160 meters of any DK weight yarn

\text { Featured garments: } & \text { Orange/green: Size } 3 \mathrm{~m} \text {, used } 70 \mathrm{~m} \text { of Wisdom Yarns Fresco } \\
\text { Coral: Size } 6 \mathrm{~m} \text {, used } 100 \mathrm{~m} \text { of Drops Muskat }
\end{array}
$$

4 mm/US 6 crochet hook, or size to get gauge.


## Abbreviations:

> Ch $=$ Chain
> Dc $=$ Double crochet

Sk = skip
Chsp = chain space
St $=$ Stitch

## Pattern notes:

Pattern uses US crochet terms.
Beginning ch3 count as a dc.
Size it determined by the length of the back.

Tie:

- Ch 4, dc in 4th ch from hook, turn.
- Ch3, dc, turn.
- Repeat last row until work measures appr $25 / 25 / 30 / 30 \mathrm{~cm}$ or $10 / 10 / 12 / 12$ inches, or to desired length - continue with front flap.


## Front flap 1:

- Ch3, dc in same st, 2 dc in last st, turn.
- Ch3, dc in same st, dc in the next 2 sts, 2 dc in last st, turn.
- Ch3, dc in same st, dc in the next 4 sts, 2 dc in last st, turn.
- Ch3, dc in same st, ch1, sk1, dc in the next 4 sts, ch1, sk1, 2 dc in last st, turn.
- Ch3, dc in same st, ch1, sk1, dc in chsp, dc in each dc to chsp, dc in chsp, ch1, sk1, 2 dc in last st, turn.
- Repeat last row 4/5/6/7 more times.


## Armhole 1:

- Ch3, dc in next st, dc in chsp, ch14/16/18/20 (1 for each dc until next chsp), dc in chsp, dc in next 2 st, turn.
- Ch3, dc in next st, ch1, sk1, dc in each ch, ch1, sk1, dc in the next 2 sts, turn.


## Back:

- Ch3, dc in next st, ch1, sk chsp, dc in each dc to chsp, sk chsp, ch1, dc in the next 2 sts, turn.
- Repeat last row until work measures 8/8.5/9/10 inches from armhole.


## Armhole 2:

- Ch3, dc in the next st, dc in chsp, ch14/16/18/20 (1 for each dc until next chsp), dc in chsp, dc in the next 2 sts, turn.
- Ch3, dc in the next st, ch1, sk1, dc in each ch, ch1, sk1, dc in the next 2 sts, turn.



## Front flap 2:

- Ch3, sk1, dc in chsp, ch1, sk1, dc until 1 dc before chsp, ch1, sk1, dc in chsp, sk1, dc in last st, turn.
- Repeat the last row until you have 8 dc left (you've just worked the following row: Ch3, sk1, dc in chsp, ch1, sk1, dc in the next 4 sts, ch1, sk1, dc in chsp, sk1, dc in the last st, turn.)
- Ch3, sk1, dc in chsp, dc in the next 4 sts, dc in chsp, sk1, dc in the last st, turn.
- Ch3, sk1, dc in the next 4 sts, sk1, dc in last st, turn.
- Ch3, sk1, dc in the next 2 sts, sk1, dc in last st, turn.
- SI st to next st, ch3, dc in the next st (skip last st), turn.
- Ch3, dc in the last st, turn.
- Repeat last row until tie have the same length as the first one. Finish off.


## Sleeves:

- Join yarn at armhole. Work one round of sc (one st for every st), then one round of dc.

Weave in ends. Finished!
