



# Apples!

## Sizes:

### Newborn

(chest: 16 inches/40 cm)

### 3 months

(chest: 17 inches/43 cm)

### 6 months

(chest: 18 inches/45 cm)

### 12 months

(chest: 20 inches/51 cm)

### 24 months

(chest: 22 inches/55 cm)

## Gauge:

5 sts and 6 rows  
per inch over  
stockinette.



## Materials:

DK weight yarn:

100/120/150/220/240 meters of MC

60/80/100/120/140 meters of CC.

4 mm knitting needles, or size to get  
gauge.

4.5 mm knitting needles, or size to get gauge. (for the colorwork part)

*(Featured garment is size newborn and knitted in Cascade Wool 220/Cascade Wool 220  
Heathers, 100m of MC, 60m of CC.)*

## Notions:

4 stitch markers, one different from the others

Two small buttons

A few meters of green yarn for the apple leaves





**Note:**  
Buttons will end up on the right shoulder, not left as photos show.

### Abbreviations

**K** = knit  
**P** = purl  
**sts** = stitches  
**CO** = cast on  
**pm** = place marker  
**sm** = slip marker  
**kfb** = knit into the front and back loop of the stitch  
**no** = number

## Yoke:

With CC, loosely CO 52/58/60/64/70 sts, for example using the long tail cast on over two needles.

Working flat:

- 1: \*K1 tbl, P1\*, repeat \*-\* to the end.
- 2: \*K1, P1 tbl\*, repeat \*-\* to the end.
- 3: \*K1 tbl, P1\*, repeat \*-\* to the last 4 sts, k2tog, yo, K2. (Button hole made.)
- 4: As row 2.
- 5: As row 1.

6: With MC, purl 10/11/12/12/13 sts (sleeve), pm, purl 16/18/18/20/22 sts (back), pm, purl 10/11/12/12/13 sts (sleeve), pm, purl 16/18/18/20/22 sts (front).

Start working raglan increase:

**7: Raglan increase round - flat (no1):** \*Kfb, knit to last st before m, kfb, sm.\* Repeat \*-\* twice more. Kfb, knit to last st, kfb.

8: (WS): Purl all sts, slipping markers when required.

9: Raglan increase round (no2): \*Kfb, knit to last st before m, kfb, sm.\* Repeat \*-\* twice more. Kfb, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, yo, K1, kfb.

10 (WS): Purl all sts, slipping markers when required.

11: Work the raglan increase round (no3) to the end. Place a marker different from the others to mark both raglan point and beginning of round. Join to work in the round.

12: Knit the next round.

**13: Raglan increase round – in the round (no4):** \*Kfb, knit to last st before m, kfb, sm.\* Repeat \*-\* twice more. Kfb, knit to last st, kfb.

14: Knit all sts, slipping markers when required.

Repeat the two raglan increase rounds (rounds 13-14) 6/6/7/9/10 more times.  
 = 132/138/148/168/182 sts on the needles

Work the two raglan increase rounds one more time with CC. Don't break yarn.  
 Work them a final time with MC.  
 = 148/154/164/184/198 sts on the needles

### Dividing for sleeves:

With CC knit the front sts to the next marker and remove it, put sleeve sts on a piece of scrap yarn, remove marker, knit the back sts to the next marker and remove it, P put sleeve sts on a piece of scrap yarn. Keep the beginning of round marker in place.  
 = 80/84/88/100/108 sts on the needles.

## Body:

Knit one round with CC.  
Knit two rounds with MC.  
Knit two rounds with CC.

Keep working with alternating colors like this until you've made 4 two row stripes with CC.

Evenly increase 4/6/10/5/4 sts.

Work even in stockinette with MC until garment measure 21/24/27/30/33 cm from CO edge, or until 10 cm before desired length.

Work apple chart for your size one time.  
Knit 3 rows with MC. Break yarn.

## Edging:

With CC knit one round, then work 5 rows in twisted rib:  
\*K1 tbl, P1\*, repeat \*-\* to the end.

Loosely bind off all sts, for example using a larger needle.

## Sleeves:

Put sleeve sts back on needles.  
Join CC, leaving a longer tail to close any holes.  
Work the same edging as for the body.  
Repeat for the second sleeve.



## Finish:

Block gently, weave in ends and attach buttons.

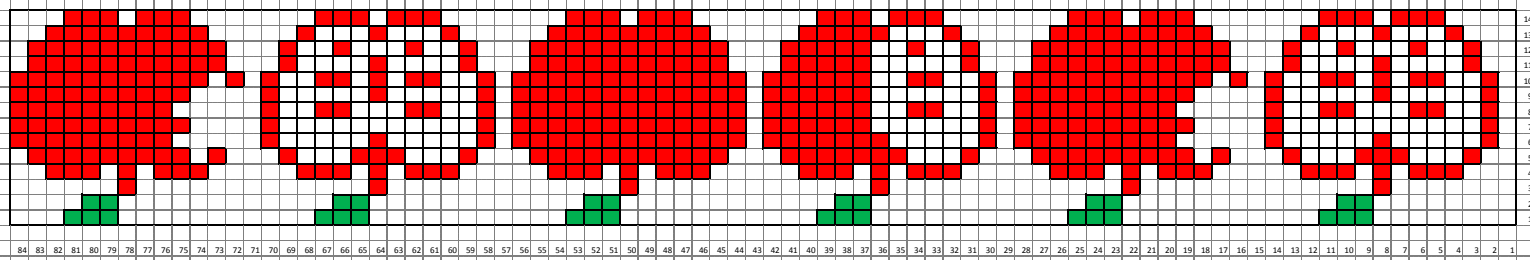


Chart 3 months

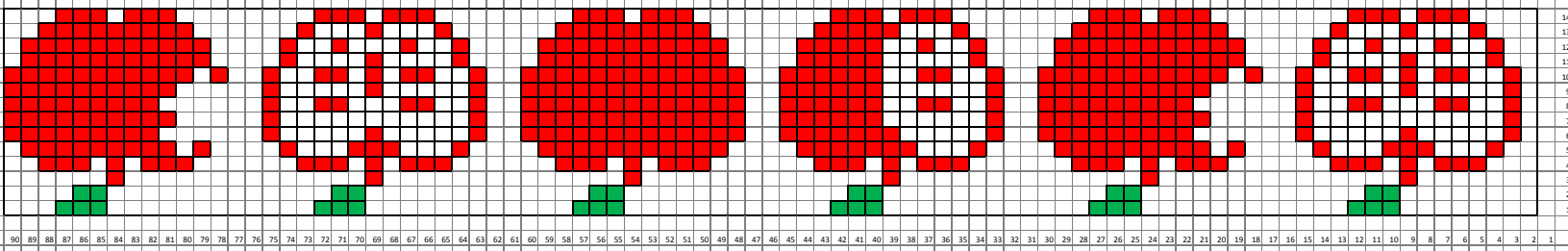


Chart 6 months
