I'm With Her

Size One size, 21 1/2" circumference x 10" tall / 54.5 cm circumference x 25 cm tall

Yarn Aran Weight, sample used Debbie Bliss Fez (85% merino, 15% camel)

Yarn A, Gray – 155 yards / 145 meters, Yarn B, Blue – 10 yards / 10 meters

Needles US #7 / 4.0 mm, or change needle to obtain gauge

2 sizes smaller needle for ribbing

Gauge 20 sts x 24 rows = 4" x 4" / 10 cm x 10 cm

Design and Construction

- Hat is knitted seamlessly from bottom up in round.
- 12 sts decreased on every decrease round for the crown.
- Contrast color arrow is knitted in flat by picking up stitches along the row first.

Abbreviations

CO Cast On

k knit

k2tog knit 2 together. Decreases 2 stitches to 1 stitch. Knit the next 2 stitches together.

LN Left Needle

p purl

p2tog purl 2 together. Decreases 2 stitches to 1 stitch. Purl the next 2 stitches together.

p2tog-tbl purl 2 together through back loops. Decreases 2 stitches to 1 stitch. Similar to p2tog, but through the back loops.

p3tog purl 3 together. Decreases 3 stitches to 1 stitch. Purl the next 3 stitches together.

pm place marker

rep repeat

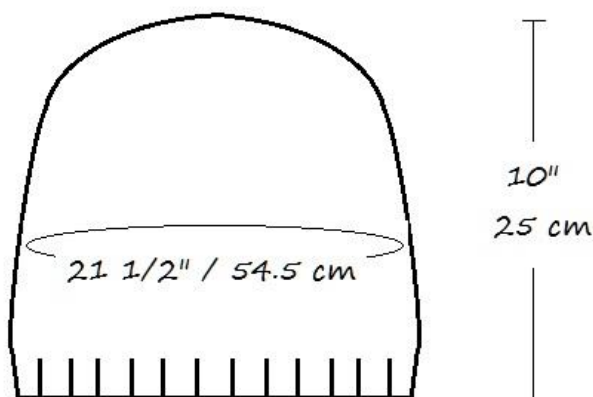
RS Right Side

sm slip marker

ssk slip, slip, knit together. Decrease 2 stitches to 1 stitch. Slip one stitch as if to knit, slip next stitch as if to knit, slip both stitches back to left needle, knit them together through the back loops.

st(s) stitch(es)

WS Wrong Side

Ribbing

With yarn A and smaller needles, CO 96 sts, join in round.

Next round: pm for beginning round, [k2, p2] 12 times, pm, k5, p4, k5, pm, p2, [k2, p2] 8 times.

Next round: sm, [k2, p2] to marker, sm, k5, p4, k5, sm, p2, [k2, p2] to end.

Rep last round for 10 more rounds.

Next round: sm, k2, m1L, [p2, k2, p2, k2, m1L] 5 times, p2, k2, m1L, p2, sm, k5, p4, k5, sm, p2, m1L, k2, p2, m1L, [k2, p2, k2, p2, m1L] 3 times, k2, p2. – 108 sts

Next round: change to larger needle, sm, p to next marker, k5, p4, k5, sm, p to end.

Rep last round for 19 more rounds.

Next round: p all sts.

Rep last round for 19 more rounds or until hat measures 8 ½" from cast on edge, to modify length of hat, lengthen or shorten here.

Crown Decreases

Round 1: [p7, p2tog] for 12 times. – 96 sts

Round 2: p all sts.

Round 3: [p6, p2tog] for 12 times. – 84 sts

Round 4: p all sts.

Round 5: [p5, p2tog] for 12 times. – 72 sts

Round 6: p all sts.

Round 7: [p4, p2tog] for 12 times. – 60 sts

Round 8: p all sts.

Round 9: [p3, p2tog] for 12 times. – 48 sts

Round 10: p all sts.

Round 11: [p2, p2tog] for 12 times. – 36 sts

Round 12: [p3tog] for 12 times. – 12 sts

Cut yarn and leave 5" / 13 cm tail. Pull yarn through all sts tightly.

Arrow

Use left needle to pick up 10 sts from the very left legs of 10 rows above ribbing of left bar (*see pictures 1, 2, 3*).

Next row (RS): join yarn, k10.

Next row (WS): p10.

Next row (RS): [sl1, k1] 5 times.

Next row (WS): sl1, p9.

Rep last 2 rows for 5 more times.

Next row, pick up sts (RS): [sl1, k1] 5 times, don't turn, use left needle to pick up 10 sts from the very left legs of last 10 rows of Right Bar, continue to k10 picked up sts (*see pictures 4 and 5*). – 20 sts

Next row, pick up sts (WS): p20, don't turn, use left needle to pick up 10 sts from the 13 rows of ribbing of Right Bar, continue to p10 picked up sts (*see pictures 6 and 7*). – 30 sts

Next Row (RS): sl1, [ssk] 2 times, k1, [sl1, k1] to last 6 sts, sl1, [k2tog] 2 times, k1. – 26 sts

Next row (WS): sl1, p to end.

Rep last 2 rows for 4 more times. – 10 sts

Next row (RS): sl1, [ssk] 2 times, [k2tog] 2 times, k1. – 6 sts

Next row (WS): sl1, p to end.

Next row (RS): sl1, ssk, k2tog, k1. – 4 sts

Next row (WS): p2tog, p2tog-tbl. – 2 sts

Cut yarn and leave 5" / 13 cm tail. Pull yarn through both sts tightly.

Secure the tail onto the WS of hat.

Finishing

Weave in ends.

Block hat to shape, and careful not to stretch ribbing during blocking.
