Sisterhood -

insist, persist, resist

Sisterhood

Size One size (adult medium)

Yarn Worsted Weight Yarn

Yarn A - Gray Heather, 100 yards. Yarn B – Light Pink, 30 yards. Yarn C – Dark Brown, 30 yards.

Needles US #6 / 4.0 mm (or change needle to obtain gauge) in you preferred method to work in round.

Also, one size larger needle to work colorwork chart.

Gauge 19 sts x 28 rows = 4" x 4" / 10 cm x 10 cm in Stockinette Stitch using larger needle, after blocking.

Measurements 18 1/2" / 47 cm around x 8 1/2" / 21.5 cm tall

Notions 1 stitch marker, tapestry needle

Construction and Design

- Slightly slouchy hat with the words "insist - persist - resist" near the base, and stripes of contrast colors at the crown.
- Hat is knitted in round from bottom up.
- Work 9 rounds of ribbing.
- Work one stripe.
- Work 9 rounds of chart.
- Work stripes by alternating yarn A with yarn B every 2 rounds.
- Work 13 rounds of crown decreases.

Abbreviations

k knit

p purl

st(s) stitch(es)

CO Cast On

pm place marker

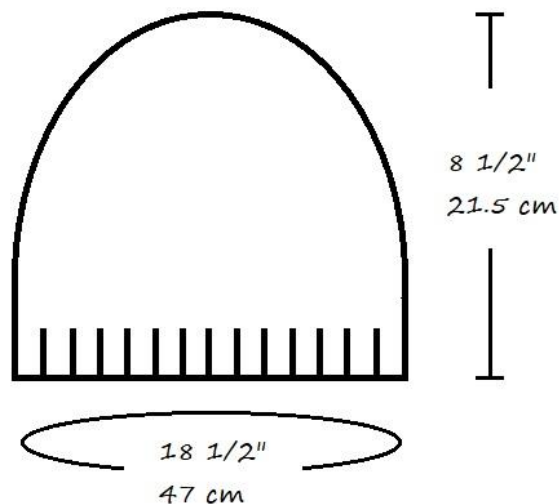
sm slip marker

rep repeat

m1L make 1 Left. An increase stitch. Lift the bar between the stitch on right needle and the stitch on left needle from front to back, and knit into the back leg.

k2tog knit 2 together. Decreases 2 stitches to 1 stitch. Knit the next 2 stitches together.

ssk slip, slip, knit together. Decrease 2 stitches to 1 stitch. Slip one stitch as if to knit, slip next stitch as if to knit, slip both stitches back to left needle, knit them together through the back loops.



Sisterhood

With yarn A and smaller needle, CO 88 sts, join in round.

Next round: pm for beginning of round, [k1, p1] to end.

Rep last round for 8 more rounds.

K 2 rounds.

Join yarn B, k 2 rounds in yarn B.

Change to yarn A, k 1 rounds in yarn A.

Next round: work in yarn A, sm, {k12, m1L, [k13, m1L] 2 times} 2 times, k12, m1L. – 95 sts

Begin Chart

Next round: change to larger needle, join yarn C, sm, work round 1 of chart to end. *(Optional: place marker every 10 sts or between words for ease of following chart.)*

Next round: sm, work round 2 of chart.

Next round: sm, work round 3 of chart.

Continue to work all 9 rounds of chart. Cut yarn C.

Change to smaller needle and k 1 round in yarn A.

Next round: work in yarn A, sm, [k17, k2tog] 5 times. – 90 sts

Change to yarn B, k 2 rounds.

Change to yarn A, k 2 rounds.

Change to yarn B, k 2 rounds.

Rep last 4 rounds for 4 more time, or until 1 ½" / 4 cm before desired length. *(Optional: use yarn C in place of yarn B on the second rep as shown in sample.)*

Crown

Continue to alternate 2 rounds of yarn A and 2 rounds of yarn B until last round of crown.

Round 1: sm, k all sts.

Round 2: sm, [k13, ssk] 6 times. – 84 sts

Round 3: sm, k all sts.

Round 4: sm, [k5, ssk] 12 times. – 72 sts

Round 5: sm, k all sts.

Round 6: sm, [k4, ssk] 12 times. – 60 sts

Round 7: sm, k all sts

Round 8: sm, [k3, ssk] 12 times. – 48 sts

Round 9: sm, k all sts.

Round 10: sm, [k2, ssk] 12 times. – 36 sts

Round 11: sm, k all sts.

Round 12: sm, [k1, ssk] 12 times. – 24 sts

Round 13: sm, [ssk] 12 times. – 12 sts

Cut yarn and leave a 5" / 13 cm tail. Pull the tail through all sts tightly, weave in tail end.

Weave in all ends.

Block into shape.
