Yarn quantities can vary and are therefore approximate requirements only. Use only Bendigo yarns as specified.

## ACCESSORIES

4.00mm crochet hook.

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain, dc = double crochet, sl = slip, sp = space, $s t=$ stitch, $\mathrm{tr}=$ treble.

Note: This pattern is written using UK terms.

## BLANKET

C1 $=36$ Granny Squares
C2 $=30$ Granny Squares
C3 $=30$ Granny Squares
C4 = 25 Granny Squares
Make the required quantity of Granny Squares in each colour using the instructions below.

## GRANNY SQUARE

Using a 4.00mm hook make 6 ch , join 1st ch and last ch with a sl st to form a ring.
Round 1: 2 ch, 2 tr, 3 ch, *3 tr, 3 ch into ring, rep from * twice, sl st to first 2 ch .
Round 2: SI st to first sp (2 ch, $2 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ ) into first 3 ch sp *(1 ch, $3 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ ) into next 3 ch sp rep from * twice, 1 ch, join with a sl st.
Round 3: SI st to first sp (2 ch, $2 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ ) into first 3 ch sp , *1 ch, 3 tr into 1 ch sp (1 ch , 3 $\mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{ch}, 3 \mathrm{tr}$ ) into each corner, rep from * ending 1 ch, sl st to join.
Round 4: SI st to first sp (2 ch, 2 tr, $3 \mathrm{ch}, 3$ tr) into first 3 ch sp, *1 ch, 3 tr into each 1 ch sp (1 ch, 3 tr, 3 ch, 3 tr) into each corner, rep from *, ending 1 ch , sl st to join.
Continue to work rounds in this manner until square measures $10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$. Fasten off.

## EDGING ROUND

Join C4 in corner sp. 2 dc into corner, 1 dc into each st to next corner, *3 dc into corner, 1 dc into each each st to next corner, rep from * twice, 1 dc into last corner, sl st into first dc to join.

Join squares together using C4 and the layout given below.

## BLANKET BORDER

Join yarn in corner of Blanket, ch 2, 1 tr in corner, work 1 tr into each st to next corner, *3 tr into next corner, 1 tr into each st to next corner, rep from * twice, 1 tr into last corner and join with a sl st into top of 2 chain at start of round. Fasten off. Join C3 into top of any treble and work 1 dc into each tr to corner, work 3 dc into middle treble at corner, continue working dc into each st and 3 dc into corners (as before) until round is complete. Join with a sl st to first dc to close the round. Fasten off.

## TO MAKE UP

Weave in ends. Press lightly with a warm iron and a damp cloth.
