PT 8433 SCARVES

Scarves can be changed in length or width to suit the individual. Simply remove or add stitches when casting on for width and knit scarf to desired length. Make sure to adjust the quantity to correspond with the changes.

TENSION

Unlike knitting a garment a tension measurement is not crucial when knitting a scarf. Therefore no tension measurements have been included. Quantities are approximate as they can vary between knitters. Use only Bendigo yarns as specified.

ABBREVIATIONS

alt = alternate, K = knit, pssso = pass slipped stitch over, P = purl, rep = repeat, st/s = stitch/es, sl = slip, tog = together, yfrn = yarn forward round needle, yfwd = yarn forward, yon = yarn over needle.

DIAGONAL SCARF

Approx Length 140cm
Approx Width 18cm

Bendigo Yarn Requirements x 200g

8 Ply Aurora 1 ball

ACCESSORIES

1 pair 4.00mm knitting needles.

SCARF

Using 4.00mm needles cast on 44 sts.

1st Row: *K2, P2, rep from * to end.

2nd and alt Rows: Knit all knit sts and purl all purl sts as they appear.

3rd Row: *K1, P2, K1, rep from * to end.

5th Row: *P2, K2, rep from * to end.

7th Row: *P1, K2, P1, rep from * to end.

8th Row: As 2nd row.

Rep these 8 rows until scarf measures approx 140cm.

Cast off loosely.

CHECK SCARF

Approx Length 130cm
Approx Width 21cm

Bendigo Yarn Requirements x 200g

8 Ply Aurora 1 ball

ACCESSORIES

1 pair 4.00mm knitting needles.

SCARF

Using 4.00mm needles cast on 35 sts.

1st Row (right side): K5, *P5, K5, rep from * to end.

2nd Row: P5, *K5, P5, rep from * to end.

Rep the last 2 rows once more then the 1st row again.

6th Row: K5, *P5, K5, rep from * to end.

7th Row: As 2nd row.

Rep the last 2 rows once more then 6th row again.

Rep these 10 rows until scarf measures approx 130cm.

Cast off loosely.

ROSEBUD SCARF

Approx Length 130cm
Approx Width 19cm

Bendigo Yarn Requirements x 200g

8 Ply Aurora 1 ball

ACCESSORIES

1 pair 5.00mm knitting needles.

SCARF

Using 5.00mm needles cast on 32 sts.

Note: Stitches should only be counted after the 4th row of this pattern.

1st Row (right side): P2, *yon, K1, yfrn, P2, rep from * to end.

2nd Row: K2, *P3, K2, rep from * to end.

3rd Row: P2, *K3, P2, rep from * to end.

4th Row: K2, *P3tog, K2, rep from * to end.

Rep these 4 rows until scarf measures approx 130cm.

Cast off loosely.

TRELLIS SCARF

Approx Length 160cm
Approx Width 17cm

Bendigo Yarn Requirements x 200g

8 Ply Aurora 1 ball

ACCESSORIES

1 pair 6.00mm knitting needles.

SCARF

Using 6.00mm needles cast on 37 sts.

Work 4 rows garter st (knit every row).

5th Row (right side): K1, *K2tog, yfwd, K1, yfwd, sl 1, K1, pssso, rep from * to last st, K1.

6th Row: Purl.

Rep rows 5 and 6 until scarf measures approx 160cm, finish with 3 rows garter st.

Cast off loosely.

FRINGE (Optional)

Fringes can be added to any of these scarves. Fringes can be worked along the ends of your scarf as follows. Cut lengths of yarn just over twice the required length of the finished fringe. Fold a few strands in half (how many depends on how thick you want the fringe and how close together the knots are) and draw a loop through the edge stitch using a crochet hook. Now draw the loose ends of strands through the loop and pull down lightly to form a knot. Repeat as required at intervals along edge. Trim ends. Note: more yarn will be required if adding a fringe.
