## **PT 8556**

### **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx Finished Size = 106cm x 106cm

### **BENDIGO WOOLLEN MILLS YARN REQUIREMENTS x 200g BALLS**

8 Ply Bloom, Classic, Luxury, Rustic

Main Colour (**MC**) x 4 balls and Contrast Colour (**CC**) x 2 balls

Yarn quantities can vary and are therefore approximate requirements only. Use only Bendigo yarns as specified.

**TENSION** - One square equals 17.5cm x 17.5cm on 4.50mm needles. Tension is not essential for this blanket, however, stated measurements and yarn quantities are based on this tension.

**ABBREVIATIONS** - CC = contrast colour, K = knit, K2tog = knit 2 stitches together, K3tog = knit 3 stitches together, MC = main colour, psso = pass slipped stitch over, rem = remain, rep = repeat, sl = slip, st/s = stitch/es.

**NOTE** - This blanket is worked on larger needles than is usually recommended for this yarn.

### **BLANKET**

Using 4.50mm needles and **MC** cast on 61 sts.

**1st Row:** Knit.

**2nd Row (right side):** K29, sl 1, K2tog, psso, K29.

**3rd Row:** Knit.

**4th Row:** K28, sl 1, K2tog, psso, K28.

**5th Row:** Knit.

Continue working in this way decreasing 2 sts at centre of every right-side row until 3 sts rem, ending with a wrong side row.

**Next Row:** K3tog.

Fasten off.

Make 36 squares.

### **TO MAKE UP**

Join four squares together (as pictured) until you have 9 large squares.

With right side facing, using 4.50mm needles and **CC**, knit up 60 sts along one side of large square.

Knit 8 rows garter stitch.

Cast off.

With right side facing, using 4.50mm needles and **CC**, knit up 65 sts along next edge of square, including the side of the **CC** on previous edge.

Knit 8 rows garter stitch.

Cast off.

Rep last 8 rows on 3rd side of square.

On last side of square, with right side facing, using 4.50mm needles and **CC**, knit up 70 sts along edge of square, including the sides of the **CC** strip on 3rd and 1st edge.

Knit 8 rows garter stitch.

Cast off.

Work edging as above for remaining 8 squares.

Join all 9 squares together with a flat seam.

### **BLANKET BORDER**

With right side facing, using 4.50mm needles and **CC** knit up 210 sts across top of blanket.

Knit 8 rows garter stitch.

Cast off.

Rep for bottom edge of blanket.

With right side facing, using 4.50mm needles and **CC** knit up 220 sts across one edge of blanket.

Knit 8 rows garter stitch.

Cast off.

Rep for other side edge of blanket.

Press lightly with a warm iron and a damp cloth.
