ACCESSORIES

A 4.00mm crochet hook or size hook to give correct tension.


TENSION

16tr and 9 rows to 10cm over treble fabric, using a 4.00mm hook. It is essential to check your tension before commencing this garment, therefore work a tension square. If there are more stitches to 10cm use a larger hook. If there are less stitches to 10cm use a smaller hook.

Note: this pattern uses Australian/UK crochet terms

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = beginning, ch = chain, cont = continue, dc = double crochet,
dec = decrease - *yarn over hook and draw up a loop in next st, yarn over
hook and draw through 2 loops, rep from * in next st, yarn over hook and
draw through all 3 loops on hook, foll = following, htr = half treble,
inc = increasing, lp = loop, rep = repeat, sl = slip, st/s = stitch/es,
tr = treble crochet, yoh = yarn over hook.



BACK

Using a 4.00mm hook, make 4ch.

Foundation Row: Miss 3ch (counts as 1tr), yoh, insert hook under 2 strands of next ch, draw lp through, yoh and draw through 1 lp (ch made), (yoh and draw through 2 lps) twice (tr made), *yoh, insert hook under 2 strands of ch made, draw lp through, yoh and draw through 1 lp (ch made), (yoh and draw through 2 lps) twice (tr made), rep from * 50 (**54**, 58, **65**, 69) times. 53 (**57**, 61, **68**, 72) sts.

Next Row: (1dc, 1ch) in first st (counts as first tr), 1tr in each st to end. 53 (57, 61, 68, 72) sts.

Rep last row until work measures 22 (25, 29, 31, 33)cm from beg.

Shape Raglan Armholes

1st Row: SI st in each of first 2tr, (1dc 1ch) in next tr, 1tr in each of next 48 (**52**, 56, **63**, 67) tr, turn, leaving last 2tr unworked. 49 (**53**, 57, **64**, 68) sts.** **2nd Row:** (1dc, 1ch) in first st dec, 1tr in each st to last 3 sts, dec, 1tr in last st. 47 (**51**, 55, **62**, 66) sts. **3rd Row:** (1dc, 1ch) in first st, 1tr in each st to end. Rep last 2 rows 4 (**5**, 3, **2**, 0) times.

39 (41, 49, 58, 66) sts.

Dec 1 st (as before) at each end of every row until 31 (33, 33, 34, 34) sts rem.

Shape Back Neck

Next Row: (1dc, 1ch), in first tr, dec, 1tr in each of next 2 tr, 1htr in each of next 3 (4, 4, 4, 4) tr, 1dc in each of next 4 tr, sl st in each of next 7 (7, 7, 8, 8) tr, 1dc in each of next 4 tr, 1htr in each of next 3 (4, 4, 4, 4) tr, 1tr in each of next 2 tr, dec, 1tr in last tr. Fasten off.

FRONT

Work as for Back to **.

Next Row: (1dc, 1ch), in first tr, dec, 1tr in each tr to last 3 sts, dec, 1tr in last st. 47 (**51**, 55, **62**, 66) sts. Rep last row until 31 (**31**, 37, **40**, 44) sts rem.

Shape Neck

1st Row: (1dc, 1ch) in first st, dec, 1tr in each of next 2 (**2**, 4, **4**, 4) sts, dec, 1 tr in next tr, turn.

Cont on these 6 (6, 8, 8, 8) sts for first side of neck. 2nd Row: (1dc, 1ch) in first st, dec, 1tr, in each of

next 0 (0, 2, 2, 2) sts, dec, 1tr in last st. 4 (4, 6, 6, 6) sts.

Sizes 8, 10 and 12 Only

3rd Row: (1dc, 1ch) in first st, (dec) twice, 1tr in last st.

All Sizes: 4 sts.

Next Row: 2ch, miss first tr, 1tr in next st, dec. **Next Row:** 2ch, miss first tr, 1tr in next st. Fasten off.

Note: Front is 2 rows shorter than the Back.

With right side facing, miss next 15 (15, 17, 20, 24) tr, join yarn with a sl st in next tr for other side of Neck. 1st Row: (1dc, 1ch) in same st as sl st, dec, 1tr in each tr to last 3 tr, dec, 1tr in last tr. 6 (6, 8, 8, 8) sts. 2nd Row: (1dc, 1ch) in first st, dec, 1tr in each of next 0 (0, 2, 2, 2) sts, dec, 1tr in last st.

Sizes 8, 10 and 12 Only

3rd Row: (1dc, 1ch) in first st, (dec) twice, 1tr in last st.

All Sizes: 4 sts.

4 (**4**, 6, **6**, 6) sts.

Next Row: 2ch, miss first tr, 1tr in next st, dec. **Next Row:** 2ch, miss first tr, 1tr in next st. Fasten off.

LEFT SLEEVE

Using 4.00mm hook, make 4ch. Work Foundation row as for Back until there are 26 (27, 28, 29, 30) sts, ch 1, turn.

Work 1 row tr.

Next Row: (1dc, 1ch, 1tr) in first tr (counts as 2 tr), 1tr in each tr to last st, 2 tr in last st. 28 (29, 30, 31, 32) sts. Cont in tr fabric, inc 1 st (as before) at each end of every foll 2nd (2nd, 2nd, 3rd, 3rd) row until there are 40 (39, 34, 43, 40) tr, then in every foll 3rd (3rd, 3rd, 4th, 4th) row until there are 42 (45, 46, 47, 48) sts. Cont in tr fabric until Sleeve measures 23 (28, 33, 38, 40)cm from beg.

Shape Raglan

1st Row: SI st in each of first 2 tr, (1dc, 1 ch) in next tr, 1tr in each of next 37 (**40**, 41, **42**, 43) tr, turn, leaving last 2tr unworked. 38 (**41**, 42, **43**, 44) sts. **2nd Row:** (1dc, 1ch) in first tr, dec, 1tr in each tr to last 3 tr, dec, 1tr in last tr. 36 (**39**, 40, **41**, 42) sts.

3rd Row: As 2nd row.

Work 1 row tr.

Rep last 2 rows 0 (1, 1, 3, 3) times.

34 (**35**, 36, **33**, 34) sts.

Dec 1 st (as before) at each end of every row until 14 (**15**, 16, **17**, 18) sts rem.***

Shape Top Edge of Sleeve

Next Row: (1dc, 1ch), in first tr, dec, 1tr in each of next 2 (**3**, 3, **3**, 4) tr, 1htr in each of next 3 (**3**, 4, **4**, 4) tr, 1 dc in each of next 3 (**3**, 3, **4**, 4) tr, turn.

Next Row: SI st in each of next 3 (**3**, 3, **4**, 4) sts, 1ch, 1dc in each of next 2 (**2**, 3, **3**, 3) sts, 1htr in each of next 2 (**3**, 3, **3**, 4) sts, dec, 1tr in last tr. Fasten off.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Work as for Left Sleeve to ***.

Shape Top Edge of Sleeve

Next Row: Sl st in each of first 3 sts, 1ch, 1dc in each of next 3 (**3**, 3, **4**, 4) tr, 1htr in each of next 3 (**3**, 4, **4**, 4) tr, 1tr in each of next 2 (**3**, 3, **3**, 4) tr, dec, 1 tr in last tr.

Next Row: (1dc, 1ch) in first tr, dec, 1htr in each of next 2 (**3**, 3, **3**, 4) sts, 1 dc in each of next 2 (**2**, 3, **3**, 3) sts.

Fasten off, leaving last st unworked.

NECKBAND

Join raglan seams, noting that shaped tops of Sleeves form part of Neckline.

With right side facing, using 4.00mm hook, work 6 rounds dc evenly around Neck edge, dec as necessary to keep work flat.

Fasten off.

TO MAKE UP

Join side and sleeve seams. Press lightly with a warm iron and a damp cloth.
