Yarn quantities can vary between crocheters and are therefore approximate requirements. Use only Bendigo yarns as specified.

## ACCESSORIES

A 4.00 mm crochet hook or size hook to give correct tension.

## TENSION

16 tr and 9 rows to 10 cm over treble fabric, using a 4.00 mm hook. It is essential to check your tension before commencing this garment, therefore work a tension square. If there are more stitches to 10 cm use a larger hook. If there are less stitches to 10 cm use a smaller hook.

## Note: this pattern uses Australian/UK crochet terms

## ABBREVIATIONS

beg = beginning, ch = chain, cont = continue, dc = double crochet, dec = decrease - *yarn over hook and draw up a loop in next st, yarn over hook and draw through 2 loops, rep from * in next st, yarn over hook and draw through all 3 loops on hook, foll = following, htr = half treble, inc $=$ increasing, $\mid \mathbf{p}=$ loop, rep $=$ repeat, $\mathbf{s l}=$ slip, $\mathbf{s t} / \mathbf{s}=$ stitch/es, tr = treble crochet, yoh = yarn over hook.


## BACK

Using a 4.00 mm hook, make 4ch.
Foundation Row: Miss 3ch (counts as 1tr), yoh, insert hook under 2 strands of next ch, draw lp through, yoh and draw through 1 lp (ch made), (yoh and draw through 2 lps) twice (tr made), *yoh, insert hook under 2 strands of ch made, draw lp through, yoh and draw through 1 lp (ch made), (yoh and draw through 2 lps) twice (tr made), rep from * 50 (54, 58, $65,69)$ times. $53(57,61,68,72)$ sts.
Next Row: (1dc, 1ch) in first st (counts as first tr), 1tr in each st to end. $53(57,61,68,72)$ sts.
Rep last row until work measures $22(25,29,31$, 33)cm from beg.

## Shape Raglan Armholes

1st Row: Sl st in each of first $2 \mathrm{tr},(1 \mathrm{dc} 1 \mathrm{ch})$ in next tr,
1 tr in each of next $48(52,56,63,67) \mathrm{tr}$, turn, leaving last 2 tr unworked. $49(53,57,64,68)$ sts.**
2nd Row: ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$ ) in first st dec, 1 tr in each st to last 3 sts, dec, 1 tr in last st. $47(51,55,62,66)$ sts. 3rd Row: ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$ ) in first st, 1 tr in each st to end. Rep last 2 rows $4(5,3,2,0)$ times.
$39(41,49,58,66)$ sts.
Dec 1 st (as before) at each end of every row until 31 $(33,33,34,34)$ sts rem.

## Shape Back Neck

Next Row: (1dc, 1ch), in first tr, dec, 1 tr in each of next $2 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{htr}$ in each of next $3(4,4,4,4) \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$ in each of next 4 tr , sl st in each of next $7(7,7,8,8) \mathrm{tr}$, 1 dc in each of next $4 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{htr}$ in each of next $3(4,4$, 4, 4) $\mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in each of next 2 tr , dec, 1 tr in last tr. Fasten off.

## FRONT

Work as for Back to **.
Next Row: (1dc, 1ch), in first tr, dec, 1 tr in each tr to last 3 sts, dec, 1 tr in last st. $47(51,55,62,66)$ sts. Rep last row until $31(31,37,40,44)$ sts rem.

## Shape Neck

1st Row: ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$ ) in first st, dec, 1 tr in each of next $2(\mathbf{2}, \mathbf{4}, \mathbf{4}, 4)$ sts, dec, 1 tr in next tr, turn.
Cont on these $6(6,8,8,8)$ sts for first side of neck. 2nd Row: (1dc, 1ch) in first st, dec, 1 tr , in each of
next $0(\mathbf{0}, 2, \mathbf{2}, 2)$ sts, dec, 1 tr in last st. $4(\mathbf{4}, 6,6,6)$ sts.

## Sizes 8, 10 and 12 Only

3rd Row: (1dc, 1ch) in first st, (dec) twice, 1 tr in last st. All Sizes: 4 sts.
Next Row: 2ch, miss first tr, 1tr in next st, dec.
Next Row: 2ch, miss first tr, 1 tr in next st.

## Fasten off.

## Note: Front is $\mathbf{2}$ rows shorter than the Back.

With right side facing, miss next $15(15,17,20,24) t r$, join yarn with a sl st in next tr for other side of Neck. 1st Row: (1dc, 1ch) in same st as sl st, dec, 1 tr in each tr to last 3 tr , dec, 1 tr in last tr. $6(6,8,8,8) \mathrm{sts}$. 2nd Row: ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$ ) in first st, dec, 1 tr in each of next $0(\mathbf{0}, 2,2,2)$ sts, dec, 1 tr in last st.
$4(4,6,6,6)$ sts.

## Sizes 8, 10 and 12 Only

3rd Row: (1dc, 1ch) in first st, (dec) twice, 1 tr in last st. All Sizes: 4 sts.
Next Row: 2ch, miss first tr, 1tr in next st, dec.
Next Row: 2ch, miss first tr, 1 tr in next st.
Fasten off.

## LEFT SLEEVE

Using 4.00 mm hook, make 4ch.
Work Foundation row as for Back until there are $26(\mathbf{2 7}, 28, \mathbf{2 9}, \mathbf{3 0})$ sts, ch 1 , turn.

## Work 1 row tr.

Next Row: ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ ) in first tr (counts as 2 tr ), 1 tr in each tr to last st, 2 tr in last st. $28(29,30,31,32)$ sts. Cont in tr fabric, inc 1 st (as before) at each end of every foll 2nd (2nd, 2nd, 3rd, 3rd) row until there are $40(39,34,43,40)$ tr, then in every foll 3rd (3rd, 3rd, 4th, 4th) row until there are $42(45,46,47,48)$ sts. Cont in tr fabric until Sleeve measures 23 (28, 33, 38, 40)cm from beg.

## Shape Raglan

1st Row: Sl st in each of first 2 tr , ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$ ) in next $\mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in each of next $37(40,41,42,43) \mathrm{tr}$, turn, leaving last 2 tr unworked. $38(41,42,43,44)$ sts. 2nd Row: ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$ ) in first tr , dec, 1 tr in each tr to last $3 \mathrm{tr}, \mathrm{dec}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in last tr. $36(39,40,41,42)$ sts. 3rd Row: As 2nd row.
Work 1 row tr.

Rep last 2 rows $0(1,1,3,3)$ times. $34(35,36,33,34)$ sts.
Dec 1 st (as before) at each end of every row until $14(15,16,17,18)$ sts rem.***

## Shape Top Edge of Sleeve

Next Row: (1dc, 1ch), in first tr, dec, 1 tr in each of next $2(3,3,3,4)$ tr, 1 htr in each of next $3(3,4,4$, 4) tr, 1 dc in each of next $3(3,3,4,4) \mathrm{tr}$, turn.

Next Row: Sl st in each of next $3(3,3,4,4)$ sts, 1 ch , 1 dc in each of next $2(2,3,3,3)$ sts, 1 htr in each of next $2(3,3,3,4)$ sts, dec, 1 tr in last tr.

## Fasten off.

## RIGHT SLEEVE

Work as for Left Sleeve to ***.

## Shape Top Edge of Sleeve

Next Row: SI st in each of first 3 sts, 1ch, 1dc in each of next $3(3,3,4,4) \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{htr}$ in each of next $3(3,4$,
$4,4) \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}$ in each of next $2(3,3,3,4) \mathrm{tr}$ dec, 1 tr in last tr.
Next Row: ( $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{ch}$ ) in first tr, dec, 1 htr in each of next $2(\mathbf{3}, 3,3,4)$ sts, 1 dc in each of next $2(2,3,3$, 3) sts.

Fasten off, leaving last st unworked.

## NECKBAND

Join raglan seams, noting that shaped tops of Sleeves form part of Neckline.
With right side facing, using 4.00 mm hook, work 6 rounds dc evenly around Neck edge, dec as necessary to keep work flat.
Fasten off.

## TO MAKE UP

Join side and sleeve seams. Press lightly with a warm iron and a damp cloth.
