# FARTHING PATTERNS

# 1:12<sup>TH</sup> SCALE LADIES CHUNKY JUMPER

To fit a 51/2-inch/14 cm tall dolls house doll



Note: Cuffs may be worn down or turned up.

**Materials required:** one pair 2.00 mm/UK size 14/US size 0 knitting needles, 50 metres/56 yards 4-ply/fingering yarn, 1 stitch holder or safety pins.

Approximate finished sizes: 5 cm/2-inches from neck to hem, 4 cm/1½-inches across hem, sleeve seam - 4 cm/1½-inches

Ability Level: INTERMEDIATE

**Gauge –** 10 stitches and 13 rows = 2.5 cm over stocking/stockinette stitch

## **Abbreviations:**

**st** - stitch; **k** - knit; **p** - purl; () - repeat instructions between brackets as detailed in text; **inc** - increase by working twice into next stitch to form 2 stitches; **sst** - stocking [stockinette] stitch (1 row k, 1 row p); **k2tog** - knit next 2 sts together to form one stitch; **p2tog** - purl next 2 sts together to form one stitch;

# **JUMPER**

Back (Make 1) \*Cast on 14 sts.

Rows 1-3: (k 1, p 1) to end

Row 4: p Change to sst: Rows 5-12: sst\*\* Shape armholes:

Row 13: cast off 2 sts, k to end. [12 sts] Row 14: cast off 2 sts, p to end. [10 sts]

Rows 15-22: sst

**Row 23:** cast off 3 sts, k 3, cast off 3 sts. [4 sts] Cut yarn and leave remaining 4 sts on a stitch holder for back neck.

Front (Make 1)

Work as for back from \* to \*\*

Shape armholes:

**Row 13:** cast off 2 sts, k 3, cast off 2 sts, k 5, turn and work on these 5 sts only

**Row 14:** cast off 2 sts, p 3. [4 sts]

**Row 15:** k2tog, k 2. [3 sts]

**Row 16:** p **Rows 17--22:** sst

Cast off.

Rejoin yarn to 4 sts left on needle:

**Row 14:** p

Row 15: k 2, k2tog. [3 sts]

Row 16: p Rows 17-22: sst Cast off.

Sleeves (Make 2 alike)

Cast on 12 sts.

Rows 1-4: (k 1, p 1) to end

Change to sst: Rows 5-10: sst

Row 11: inc in 1<sup>st</sup> st, k to last st, inc in this st. [14 sts]

**Row 12:** p

Rows 13-24: sst. Sleeves may be lengthened/shortened

here. Cast off

### Collar

With right side facing you, rejoin yarn to 4 sts on stitch holder at back neck.

**Row 1:** (k 1, p 1) twice

**Row 2:** cast on 4 sts, (k 1, p 1) to end. [8 sts]

Row 3: cast on 4 sts, (k 1, p 1) to end. [12 sts]

Row 4: cast on 4 sts, (k 1, p 1) to end. [16 sts]

**Row 5:** cast on 4 sts, (k 1, p 1) to end. [20 sts] **Row 6:** cast on 2 sts, (k 1, p 1) to end. [22 sts]

Row 7: cast on 2 sts, (k 1, p 1) to end. [24 sts]

Row 8: (k 1, p 1) to end

Keeping pattern correct, cast off.

# To make up

Block if required. With right sides together, sew shoulder seams. Overlap collar at front and sew short edges of collar to cast off stitches at centre front. Sew sides of collar in place. Set in sleeves. With right sides together, sew up side and sleeve seams. Turn right side out and fold collar down.





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For scale information: the UK Penny coin used on the photos is just slightly larger than a US Cent coin. The actual diameter is ¾-inch or 2 cm. The UK penny coin sits just inside a European (Euro) 5c coin.
