



Glamour Pursey

This is a great little evening bag, that can compliment the smartest outfit.

#### Pattern Notes

A full pattern including clearly written instructions and stitch abbreviations.

## Skill Level

#### Easy

Basic stitches only. This bag is constructed from two pieces, worked flat and then sew together.

### Yarn

1 50g ball of dk mohair wool (I used Melandra Mohair)

## Needles

4mm/UK 8/USA 6 pair knitting needles (or as required for the wool you are using)

## Materials

Yarn Material for lining Ribbon (approx 0.5 cm thick) Necklace beads for handle (I brought 1 long cheap necklace and cut it in half to make the two handles) Needles and cotton for bag lining

### Size

Evening bag - Approximately 20cm (7.6") across

## Gauge

Not critical

#### Abbreviations

- **k** knit
- **p** purl

**yo** - bring the yarn to the front of the work and then knit the next stitch as normal

**k2tog** - knit the next two stitches together as one

#### Sides

#### Make two:

CO 25 Row1-5 5 rows of stocking stitch, beginning with a k row. Row 6 K 1 row Row 7-11 6 rows of stocking stitch, beginning with a k row Row 12 k1, \*yo, k1\*, repeat from \* to \* to end (49 stitches) Row 14 P row Row 15 K1, \*yo, k2\*, repeat from \* to\* to end (73 stitches) Row 16 P row Row 17-26 Stocking stitch 10 rows, beginning with a k row Row 27 k2 tog, k8, k2tog, k to last 12, k2tog, k8, k2 tog (71) Row 28 P row (and every alternate row going forward) Row 29 k2tog, k7, k2tog, k to last 11, k2 tog, k7, k2tog (69) Row 31 k2tog, k6, k2 tog, k to last10, k2tog, k6, k2tog (67) Row 33 k2tog, k5, k2tog, k to last 9, k2tog, k5, k2tog (65) Row 35 \*k1, k2tog\*, repeat from \* to \* to the last 2 stitches, k2 (44) Row 37 K2tog to end (22) Row 38 Purl to end ΒO

# Making Up

Fold tops to knit line and sew handles in place. Sew along side, bottom and up other side of bag. Tread ribbon through 1st (or 2nd) set of yo's and use fabric to line the bag.
