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Preemie/Newborn Bobble Bonnet

Materials:

Preemie

- US 4 (3.5mm) and 6 (4mm) Needles
- US 6 DPNs or circular needles using the magic loop method
- Size 3 light weight yarn. Approx. 95 yards

Newborn

- US 5 (3.75mm) and 6 (4mm) Needles
- US 6 DPNs or circular needles using the magic loop method
- Size 4 worsted yarn. Approx. 100 yards.

Key

BO - Bind Off
CO - Cast On
K- Knit
K2tog - Knit 2 together
Ktbl - Knit through the back loop
P - Purl
Rnds - Rounds
Sl - Slip
Sts - Stitches

Gauge:

Size US 6(4mm) needles
in Stockinette Stitch

11 sts x 15 rows = 2"

Bobble: In the same stitch - k1, ktbl, k1, turn. (3 sts) Purl, turn. Knit, turn. Purl, turn. Sl 1, K2tog. Psso(Pass first stitch over the last stitch and off the needle.)

With smaller needles, CO 50

Ribbing

Row 1(WS): p2, *k2, p2* to end of row
Row 2(RS): k2, *p2, k2* to end of row
Rows 3-6: Repeat rows 1-2.

Body

Change to larger needles.

Row 1: Purl

Row 2: *Bobble, k11*, repeat to last 2 stitches, bobble, k1. (5 bobbles)

Rows 3-7: stockinette stitch (purl odd rows, knit even rows).

Row 8: k6, *bobble, k11*, repeat to last 8 stitches, bobble, k7. (4 bobbles)

Rows 9-13: stockinette stitch (purl odd rows, knit even rows).

Repeat rows 2-13 until you have made 5 bobble rows (end on row 2).

Decrease Rows

Now you will be knitting in the round on the right side only. With DPNs or circular needles using the magic loop method, Join. (Your working yarn will be on your right hand needle.)

Round 1: Ssk, k8, K2tog, ssk, k9, k2tog. Repeat once. (42 sts)

Round 2 and all even rows: knit

Round 3: Ssk, k6, K2tog, ssk, k7, k2tog. Repeat once. (34 sts)

Round 5: Ssk, k4, K2tog, ssk, k5, k2tog. Repeat once. (26 sts)

Round 7: Ssk, k2, K2tog, ssk, k3, k2tog. Repeat once. (18 sts)

Round 9: Ssk, K2tog, ssk, k1, k2tog. Repeat once. (10 sts)

Round 11: K2tog, ssk. Repeat once, k2tog. (5 sts)

Cut yarn. Weave through remaining 5 sts.

Neck Band

With smaller needles, pick up 42 sts. along the bottom of the bonnet distributed evenly. (21 on first half. 21 on second half) Note: The opening of the bonnet will be facing up with the crown on the left side. Start picking up sts. on the border closest to you with the right side facing you.

Row 1(WS): P2, *K2, P2* Repeat to end of row.

Row 2(RS): K2, *P2, K2* Repeat to end of row.

Rows 3-6: Repeat rows 1-2.

BO Purl-wise.

I-cord (make 2)

With smaller needles, CO3. Instead of turning your work, slide your work on the other needle so your yarn is on the left side of your work. Knit. Repeat. I did it for 64 rows. BO.

Attach each I-cord to front edges of the bonnet.

Weave ends.

0-6 mo. Bobble Bonnet

Materials:

- US 5 (3.75mm) and 6 (4mm) Needles
- US 6 DPNs or circular needles using the magic loop method
- Size 4 worsted weight yarn. Approx. 100 yards

Key

BO - Bind Off
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K2tog - Knit 2 together
Ktbl - Knit through the back loop
P - Purl
Rnds - Rounds
Sl - Slip
Sts - Stitches

Gauge:

Size US 6(4mm) needles
in Stockinette Stitch

11 sts x 15 rows = 2"

Bobble: In the same stitch - k1, ktbl, k1, turn. (3 sts) Purl, turn. Knit, turn. Purl, turn. Sl 1, K2tog. Psso(Pass first stitch over the last stitch and off the needle.)

With smaller needles, CO 58

Ribbing

Row 1(WS): p2, *k2, p2* to end of row
Row 2(RS): k2, *p2, k2* to end of row
Rows 3-6: Repeat rows 1-2.

Body

Change to larger needles.

Row 1: Purl
Row 2: k4, *Bobble, k11*, repeat to last 6 stitches, bobble, k5. (5 bobbles)
Rows 3-7: stockinette stitch (purl odd rows, knit even rows).
Row 8: k10, *bobble, k11*, repeat end of row. (4 bobbles)
Rows 9-13: stockinette stitch (purl odd rows, knit even rows).

Repeat rows 2-13 until you have made 5 bobble rows (end on row 2)

Decrease Rows

Now you will be knitting in the round on the right side only. With DPNs or circular needles using the magic loop method, Join. (Your working yarn will be on your right hand needle.)

Round 1: Ssk, k10, K2tog, ssk, k11, k2tog. Repeat once. (50 sts)

Round 2 and all even rows: knit

Round 3: Ssk, k8, K2tog, ssk, k9, k2tog. Repeat once. (42 sts)

Round 5: Ssk, k6, K2tog, ssk, k7, k2tog. Repeat once. (34 sts)

Round 7: Ssk, k4, K2tog, ssk, k5, k2tog. Repeat once. (26 sts)

Round 9: Ssk, k2, K2tog, ssk, k3, k2tog. Repeat once. (18 sts)

Round 11: Ssk, K2tog, ssk, k1, k2tog. Repeat once. (10 sts)

Round 13: K2tog, ssk. Repeat once, k2tog. (5 sts)

Cut yarn. Weave through remaining 5 sts.

Neck Band

With smaller needles, pick up 50 sts. along the bottom of the bonnet distributed evenly. (25 on first half. 25 on second half) Note: The opening of the bonnet will be facing up with the crown on the left side. Start picking up sts. on the border closest to you with the right side facing you.

Row 1(WS): P2, *K2, P2* Repeat to end of row.

Row 2(RS): K2, *P2, K2* Repeat to end of row.

Rows 3-6: Repeat rows 1-2.

BO Purl-wise.

I-cord (make 2)

With smaller needles, CO3. Instead of turning your work, slide your work on the other needle so your yarn is on the left side of your work. Knit. Repeat. I did it for 64 rows. BO.

Attach each I-cord to front edges of the bonnet.

Weave ends.

Bobble Bonnet - 6-12 months

Materials:

- US 5 (3.75mm) and 6 (4mm) Needles
- US 6 DPNs or circular needles using the magic loop method
- Size 3-4 light weight/light worsted yarn. Approx.110 yards

Key

BO - Bind Off
CO - Cast On
K- Knit
K2tog - Knit 2 together
Ktbl - Knit through the back loop
P - Purl
Rnds - Rounds
Sl - Slip
Sts - Stitches

Gauge:

Size US 6(4mm) needles
in Stockinette Stitch

11 sts x 15 rows = 2"

Bobble: In the same stitch - k1, ktbl, k1, turn. (3 sts) Purl, turn. Knit, turn. Purl, turn. Sl 1, K2tog. Psso(Pass first stitch over the last stitch and off the needle.)

With smaller needles, CO 66

Ribbing

Row 1(WS): p2, *k2, p2* to end of row

Row 2(RS): k2, *p2, k2* to end of row

Rows 3-6: Repeat rows 1-2.

Body

Change to larger needles.

Row 1: Purl

Row 2: k8, *bobble, k11*, repeat to last 2 stitches, bobble, k9. (5 bobbles)

Rows 3-7: stockinette stitch (purl odd rows, knit even rows).

Row 8: k2, *bobble, k11*, repeat to last 3 stitches, bobble, k3. (6 bobbles)

Rows 9-13: stockinette stitch (purl odd rows, knit even rows).

Repeat rows 2-13 until you get to row 32 (end on row 8).

Decrease Rows

Now you will be knitting in the round on the right side only. With DPNs or circular needles using the magic loop method, Join. (Your working yarn will be on your right hand needle.)

Round 1: Ssk, k12, K2tog, ssk, k13, k2tog. Repeat once. (58 sts)

Round 2 and all even rnds: Knit all sts.

Round 3: Ssk, k10, K2tog, ssk, k11, k2tog. Repeat once. (50 sts)

Round 5: Ssk, k8, K2tog, ssk, k9, k2tog. Repeat once. (42 sts)

Round 7: Ssk, k6, K2tog, ssk, k7, k2tog. Repeat once. (34 sts)

Round 9: Ssk, k4, K2tog, ssk, k5, k2tog. Repeat once. (26 sts)

Round 11: Ssk, k2, K2tog, ssk, k3, k2tog. Repeat once. (18 sts)

Round 13: Ssk, K2tog, ssk, k1, k2tog. Repeat once. (10 sts)

Round 15: K2tog, ssk. Repeat once, k2tog. (5 sts)

Cut yarn. Weave through remaining 5 sts.

Neck Band

With smaller needles, pick up 56 sts. distributed evenly along the bottom of the bonnet. (The opening of the bonnet will be facing up with the crown on the left side. Start picking up sts. on the border closest to you with the right side facing you.) To help with distributing evenly, I picked up 2, skip 1, pick up 3, skip 1, keep repeating.

Row 1(WS): P2, *K2, P2* Repeat to end of row.

Row 2(RS): K2, *P2, K2* Repeat to end of row.

Rows 3-6: Repeat rows 1-2.

BO Purl-wise.

I-cord (make 2)

With smaller needles, CO3. Instead of turning your work, slide your work on the other needle so your yarn is on the left side of your work. Knit. Repeat. I did it for 64 rows. BO.

Attach each I-cord to front edges of the bonnet.

Weave ends.

Bobble Bonnet - 12-18 months

Materials:

- US 5 (3.75mm) and 6 (4mm) Needles
- US 6 DPNs or circular needles using the magic loop method
- Size 3-4 light weight/light worsted yarn. Approx. 110 yards

Key

BO - Bind Off
CO - Cast On
K- Knit
K2tog - Knit 2 together
Ktbl - Knit through the back loop
P - Purl
Rnds - Rounds
Sl - Slip
Sts - Stitches

Gauge:

Size US 6(4mm) needles
in Stockinette Stitch

11 sts x 15 rows = 2"

Bobble: In the same stitch - k1, ktbl, k1, turn. (3 sts) Purl, turn. Knit, turn. Purl, turn. Sl 1, K2tog. Psso(Pass first stitch over the last stitch and off the needle.)

With smaller needles, CO 74

Ribbing

Row 1(WS): p2, *k2, p2* to end of row
Row 2(RS): k2, *p2, k2* to end of row
Rows 3-6: Repeat rows 1-2.

Body

Change to larger needles.

Row 1: Purl
Row 2: Bobble, k11*, repeat to last 2 stitches, bobble, k1. (7 bobbles)
Rows 3-7: stockinette stitch(purl odd rows, knit even rows).
Row 8: k6, *bobble, k11*, repeat to last 8 stitches, bobble, k7. (6 bobbles)
Rows 9-13: stockinette stitch (purl odd rows, knit even rows).

Repeat rows 2-13 until you get to row 32 (end on row 8).

Decrease Rows

Now you will be knitting in the round on the right side only. With DPNs or circular needles using the magic loop method, Join. (Your working yarn will be on your right hand needle.)

Round 1: Ssk, k14, K2tog, ssk, k15, k2tog. Repeat once. (66 sts)

Round 2 and all even rnds: Knit all sts.

Round 3: Ssk, k12, K2tog, ssk, k13, k2tog. Repeat once. (58 sts)

Round 5: Ssk, k10, K2tog, ssk, k11, k2tog. Repeat once. (50 sts)

Round 7: Ssk, k8, K2tog, ssk, k9, k2tog. Repeat once. (42 sts)

Round 9: Ssk, k6, K2tog, ssk, k7, k2tog. Repeat once. (34 sts)

Round 11: Ssk, k4, K2tog, ssk, k5, k2tog. Repeat once. (26 sts)

Round 13: Ssk, k2, K2tog, ssk, k3, k2tog. Repeat once. (18 sts)

Round 15: Ssk, K2tog, ssk, k1, k2tog. Repeat once. (10 sts)

Round 17: K2tog, ssk. Repeat once, k2tog. (5 sts)

Cut yarn. Weave through remaining 5 sts.

Neck Band

With smaller needles, pick up 64 sts. along the bottom of the bonnet distributed evenly. (32 on first half. 32 on second half) Note: The opening of the bonnet will be facing up with the crown on the left side. Start picking up sts. on the border closest to you with the right side facing you.

Row 1(WS): P2, *K2, P2* Repeat to end of row.

Row 2(RS): K2, *P2, K2* Repeat to end of row.

Rows 3-6: Repeat rows 1-2.

BO Purl-wise.

I-cord (make 2)

With smaller needles, CO3. Instead of turning your work, slide your work on the other needle so your yarn is on the left side of your work. Knit. Repeat. I did it for 64 rows. BO.

Attach each I-cord to front edges of the bonnet.

Weave ends.
