



Ethereal Scarf

Scarf measures approx II" x 74" (point to point) Front and back sides are virtually the same.

Advanced Beginner

Needle size 3.75mm/US 5 (24" circular works best) Yarn used Etereo by Cloud9 Fibers (fingering weight)

Colorway I

A=Shallows B=Pearl C=Abalone D=Sea Star

Colorway 2

A=Anemone B=Dune C=Sunray D=Coppertone

Gauge is not critical, but can affect the size.

Worked in **Netted Stripe Pattern** (below) 4"= 17 stitches / 24 rows

Abbreviations:

k - knit

kfb - knit front and back (I increase)

yo - yarn over

k2tog - knit 2 together (1 decrease)

Notes

- This scarf increases at the beginning and decreases at the end of every RS Row creating a diagonal effect
- Cut yarns when changing colors leaving enough to weave in later.
- New colors will always begin on Row I RS.
- Size is easily adjustable to increase width to make a shawl be sure to use *odd* amount of stitches.

Netted Stripe Pattern (24 rows):

Row I RS kfb, knit to last 2 stitches, k2tog

Row 2 WS knit

Row 3 kfb, rep [yo, k2tog] to last 2 stitches, k2tog

Row 4 knit

Repeat Rows 3 & 4 total 10 times

Row 5 kfb, knit to last 2 stitches, k2tog

Row 6 knit

Directions

With color A, cast on 65 stitches (long tail cast on preferred).

Work color A in **Netted Stripe Pattern**

Switch to color B repeat **Netted Stripe Pattern**

Continue with each color in this manner in the following sequence.

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Cast off loosely - you may want to go up a needle size. Weave in ends.

Blocking is necessary to open up the netting effect. Soak Etereo for at least 15 minutes and stretch the scarft from side edge to side edge so openings look like squares.
