

# **Easter Treat Bag**



You will need some reasonable understanding of crocheting terms because I'm not able to provide any additional help. You're on your own here!

Crochet hook 3.75mm (F), small amount of orange & green worsted yarn Needed

Stitches ch=chain, sl=slip stitch, sc=single crochet, hdc=half double crochet

## start with orange yarn. Mark beginning of row and work in continuous circle



- 2 2sc in each st (8)
- 3 1sc in each st (8)
- 4 (1sc, 2sc in next st) 4x (12)
- 5 | 1sc in each st (12)
- 6 (1sc in next 2 st, 2sc in next st) 4x (16)
- 7 | 1sc in each st (16)
- 8 (1sc in next 3 st, 2sc in next st) 4x (20)
- 9-10 | 1sc in each st (20)
  - 11 (1sc in next 4 st, 2sc in next st) 4x (24)
- 12-13 | 1sc in each st (24)
  - 14 (1sc in next 5 st, 2sc in next st) 4x (28)
- 15-17 | 1sc in each st (28)
  - 18 (1sc in next 6 st, 2sc in next st) 4x (32)
- 19-25 | 1sc in each st (32)

#### Change to green yarn. Close every round with a sl in the 2nd ch from the start



- 26 | 1hsc 2ch 1sc in each of next 31 st close round with 1sl
- 27 | 2ch 1sc in each of next 31 st close round with 1sl
- 28 3ch (skip next st 1hdc 1ch) 15x close round with 1sl
- 29 2ch (1sc around ch, 1sc in hdc) 15x 1sc around ch close round with 1sl
- 30 (10ch 1sc in next 2 st 15ch 1sc in next 2 st) 8x close round with 1sl



# drawstring



twist orange and green yarn together or crochet a 60 chain to make a drawstring of about 45 cm and weave through holes of row 30



### finish



weave in yarn ends and fill with little Easter eggs, smarties or jelly beans
