



Small Doll Shoes

(about 4.5 cm from heel to toe)



You will need some reasonable understanding of knitting terms because I'm not able to provide any additional help. You're on your own here!

<u>Needed</u>	Needle 2.5mm, small amount of yarn, little buttons.
<u>Stitches</u>	Decrease - k2tog (knit 2 together) or k2togtbl (knit 2 together through back loop) You can knit all rows or use knit 1 row, purl 1 row, whichever you prefer

Shoes measure about 4.5cm from heel to toe

Cast on 17st and work 1 row.

Increase on next 3 rows as follows to form sole (it's easy if you mark the middle stitch!)

Increase 1st on each end and increase 1st on each side of the middle st

(4 stitches per row for 3 rows, a total of 12st. You now have 29st)

Work 4 rows without increase for the upper shoe.

purl the first row on the right side (or knit on the wrong side) if you prefer to have a ridge line between the sole and upper shoe.

decrease # 1 (6st)

k8 - k2togtbl (3x) - k1 - k2tog (3x) - k8 (23st)

Now finish depending on what kind of shoe you want:

<p>loafers</p>	10-11	Cast off now or work one more row before cast off if you want a higher fitting shoe
<p>ankle high or boots</p>	10	<u>decrease # 2 (6st)</u> k5 - k2togtbl (3x) - k1 - k2tog (3x) - k5 (17st)
	11-40	Work another 3-30 rows depending on how high you want the shoe or boot. Cast off.
<p>straps</p>	10-14	k6 - cast off 11st - k6 Work 3 more rows on each of the 6st, cast off Crochet 13 ch st on left or right side, turn, skip 5 ch (for buttonhole), 8sc to end. Finish off, sew on a small button.
