



Santa Hat - Egg Covers



You will need some reasonable understanding of crocheting terms because I'm not able to provide any additional help. You're on your own here!

<u>Needed</u>	crochet needle 3.25 mm (D), leftover red and white yarn
<u>Stitches</u>	magic ring, sc = single crochet, sc2tog = single crochet 2 together Don't close rows, just keep working in spiral fashion.

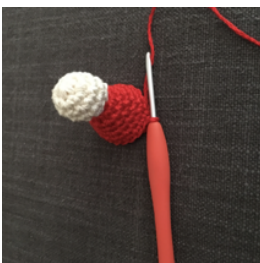
start with top of the hat



Magic ring with white yarn, 6 sc inside the ring (6)
2 sc in each stitch (12).
Work 2 rows of 1 sc in each stitch
sc2tog 6x (6).



Change to red yarn
1 sc in each stitch (6)
2 sc in each stitch (12)
Work 2 rows of 1 sc in each stitch
(2 sc in 1 stitch, 1 sc in next stitch) 6x (18)
Work 2 rows of 1 sc in each stitch
(2 sc in 1 stitch, 1 sc in next 2 stitches) 6x (24)
Work 2 rows of 1 sc in each stitch
(2 sc in 1 stitch, 1 sc in next 3 stitches) 6x (30)
Work 3 rows of 1 sc in each stitch
(2 sc in 1 stitch, 1 sc in next 4 stitches) 6x (36)



Work 3 rows of 1 sc in each stitch
Change to white yarn
Work 5 rows of 1 sc in each stitch.
Fold over white rim and secure with a few stitches.
