



TOY SHOES

(about 6cm from heel to toe)



You will need some reasonable understanding of knitting terms because I'm not able to provide any additional help.

You're on your own here!

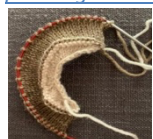
Needed small amounts of DK or Sport yarn, knitting needle 2.5mm, crochet hook 2.25mm

Stitches *KNIT:* k=knit, p=purl, *=make1 (k on rs, p on ws), 2tog=2stitches together, 2togtbl=2stitches together through back loop, ssk=slip-slip-knit, yo=yarn over, rs=right side, ws=wrong side
CROCHET: ch=chain, sc=single crochet, slst=slipstitch

start with sole (same for every style) cast on 14

odd # row = ws
even # row = rs

purl ridge method



alternative crochet method



1	p14
2	k2*k1*k3*k2*k3*k1*k2(20)
3	p20
4	k2*k1*k5*k1*k2*k1*k5*k1*k2(28)
5	p28
6	k2*k1*k8*k1*k1*k2*k1*k1*k8*k1*k2(38)
7	k38
8	p38 (<i>change colour if desired</i>)
<u>alternative method row 8 to get a crocheted chain above the sole of the shoe:</u>	
take 1 st stitch off needle with crochet hook and then insert hook BETWEEN next 2 stitches, pull up yarn to crochet a slip stitch. Repeat till the end. Put stitch back on the needle (38)	
9-15	p38 on ws, k38 on rs (<i>add pattern if desired, lacey, colour work etc, 7 row total</i>)
16	k11, k2tog 8x, k11 (30)
17	p30

shoe with strap or tie



18	Cast off.
<u>Crochet strap</u>	
ch 15, starting in 6th ch from hook (=button hole), sc 10 back to starting stitch. Sew a strap on (<i>opposite!</i>) side of each shoe, add button.	
<u>Crochet ribbon</u>	
ch 25-30 on both sides of each shoe to tie into bow.	

shoe with T-bar



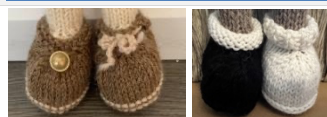
18	Cast off 11, knit 8, cast off 11 (8) - <i>cut yarn and continue with the 8 stitches on rs</i>
19 (rs)	ssk, k1, k2tog, k1, k2tog (5)
20-22	p5 on ws, k5 on rs, p5 on ws
23	ssk, k1, k2tog (3)
24	Cast off in purl. Crochet strap (<i>see above</i>) and attach the T-bar in the middle.

shoe with lace



18	k6, k2tog, yo, k2tog, yo, k1, k2tog 4x, k1, yo, k2tog, yo, k2tog, k6 (26)
19	p11, p2tog 2x, p11 (24) Cast off. Crochet ch60 to weave through eyelets

ankle boot, with or without tie



18	k11, k2tog 4x, k11 (26)
19	p11, p2tog 2x, p11 (24)
20	k11, k2tog, k11 (23) <i>change colour when starting this row if you want contrast</i>
21	k23

For top rows (2 different options)

- k 3 rows (2nd row *k2tog, yo* if you want eyelets for ribbon)
- 7 rows reverse stocking stitch or k1-p1 ribbing for a fold over edge

Cast off in pattern. If needed, crochet ch60 to weave through eyelets.

Finishing

Sew the back and bottom of the shoe. Weave in all loose ends. Add buttons, flowers or any fun decorations
