



## Cape

for 23cm - 9" toy



*You will need some reasonable understanding of craft terms because I'm not able to provide any additional help.  
You're on your own here!*

**Needed** small amount of Sport or DK yarn, 2.75mm needles, 2.25mm crochet hook

**Stitches** WS=wrong side of work, RS=right side of work  
Knitting: k=knit, p=purl, \*=increase 1 stitch,  
Crocheting: ch=chain stitch, sl=slip stitch

### start with top of cape at neck

crochet 35ch, sl back to beginning

put the stitch on knitting needle and cast on 25, use the last stitch to crochet 35ch and sl back, put the stitch back on the knitting needle.

You now have 26 stitches total with 2 cords off each end.

WS - k 1 row

RS - k 1 row and increase 6 stitches evenly across, you now have 32 stitches

*starting here always work 3 border stitches on each end in garter stitch (k every row)*

k3 - p till last 3 - k3

increase row (10 stitches)

3 border stitches - \* - 2 - \* - 1 - \* - 6 - \* - 1 - \* - 6 - \* - 1 - \* - 6 - \* - 1 - \* - 2 - \* - 3 border stitches (42)

work 5 rows

increase row (10 stitches)

3 border stitches - \* - 4 - \* - 1 - \* - 8 - \* - 1 - \* - 8 - \* - 1 - \* - 8 - \* - 1 - \* - 4 - \* - 3 border stitches (52)

work 5 rows

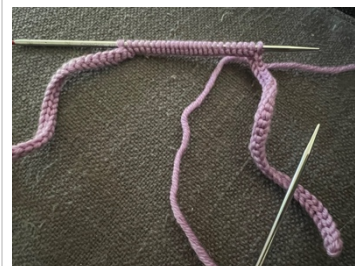
increase row (10 stitches)

3 border stitches - \* - 6 - \* - 1 - \* - 10 - \* - 1 - \* - 10 - \* - 1 - \* - 10 - \* - 1 - \* - 6 - \* - 3 border stitches (62)

Work 5 rows

k 4 rows (garter stitch)

Cast off



*If you like a longer cape you can repeat the increase row + 5 rows as many times as desired*

*If you make a very long cape stop the increase row when you feel the cape is wide enough and just keep knitting till desired length.*

*End with the 4 rows garter stitch as bottom border.*

*If you work the coloured 1 stitch between the increase (\*-1-\*) in rev stocking stitch (purl on RS and knit on WS) you get a nice defining ridge.*
