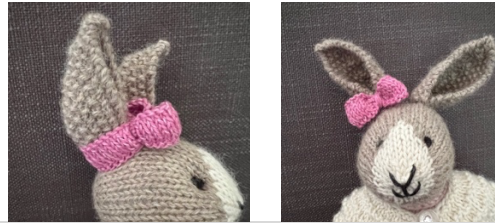


Bow for small toy animals



*You will need some reasonable understanding of craft terms because I'm not able to provide any additional help.
You're on your own here!*

This method will let you change the bow on a toy animal because it easily slides over the ear.



Long tail cast on about 35-40 stitches.
Starting and ending with a knit row, work 5 or 7 rows stocking stitch (knit 1 row, purl 1 row).
Cast off in knit (this is on the purl side).
Leave long tail for sewing.



Sew the strip into a circle.



Fold the circle in half and then sew together with 2 loops on the front.
Make sure the back loop is big enough to go over the ear of the animal you want to use it on.
Wrap the yarn several times around the middle of the 2 front loops and secure tightly.
