## Reversible Easter Egg Coaster



## SKILL LEVEL:

Easy

## FINISHED SIZE:

5" wide x 4-3/4" high
(not including fringe)

## MATERIALS:

- Crochet cotton, size 10, in small amounts:
- White (Color A)
- Aqua (Color B)
- Bright Pink (Color C)
- Teal (Color D)
- Lilac (Color E)

Suggestion: Wrap some of each color onto a second spool before using.

- Size E ( 3.50 mm ) crochet hook


## GAUGE:

Working in sc:
10 sts = 2 "
12 rows = $2^{\prime \prime}$

## SPECIAL STITCHES:

- join thread with sc - with slip knot on hook, insert hook in specified st, yo, pull up loop, yo, pull thru all loops on hook
- long hdc - yo, insert hook at base of specified st, yo, pull up loop, yo, pull thru all loops on hook (see example)

- st in center of sc - work indicated st by inserting hook thru one horizontal bar and one vertical bar of sc (see example)



## COASTER

NOTE: Leave a 4" strand at the beg and end of each row for fringe.

## Beg:

Using 2 strands of Color A held tog, ch 25 . Fasten off.

## Row 1 (RS):

Using 2 strands of Color A held tog, join thread with sc in 1st ch, sc in each of rem 24 ch across. Fasten off. Turn.

25 sc made.

## Row 2 (WS):

Using 2 strands of Color B held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, sc in each of rem 24 sts across. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 3:

Using 2 strands of Color A held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, *long
hdc in next st, sc in next, rep from * across. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 4:

Using 2 strands of Color C held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, sc in each of rem 24 sts across. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 5:

Using 2 strands of Color A held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, long hdc in next st, sc in next, long hdc in next st, sc in each of next 5, long hdc in each of next 7 sts, sc in each of next 5, (long hdc in next st, sc in next) twice. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 6:

Using 2 strands of Color D held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, sc in each of rem 24 sts across. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 7:

Using 2 strands of Color A held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, long hdc in next st, sc in next, long hdc in next st, sc in each of next 4 , long hdc in next st, sc in each of next 7, long hdc in next st, sc in each of next 4, (long hdc in next st, sc in next) twice. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 8:

Using 2 strands of Color E held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, sc in each of next 8 sts, sk next sc, (long hdc in base, sc in top, long hdc in base) of next sc, sk next sc, sc in next, sk next sc, (long hdc in base, sc in top, long hdc in base) of next sc, sk next sc, sc in each of rem 9 sts across. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 9:

Using 2 strands of Color A held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, long hdc in next st, sc in next, long hdc in next st, sc in each of next 3 , long hdc in next st, sc in each of next 9 , long hdc in next st, sc in each of next 3 , (long hdc in next st, sc in next) twice. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 10:

Using 2 strands of Color B held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, sc in each of next 6 sts, sk long hdc, *(long hdc in base, sc in top, long hdc in base) of next sc, sk next sc, sc in next, sk next sc, rep from * once, (long hdc in base, sc in top, long hdc in base) of next sc, sk long hdc, sc in each of rem 7 sts across. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 11:

Using 2 strands of Color A held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, long hdc in next st, sc in next, long hdc in next st, sc in each of next 2 , long hdc in next st, sc in each of next 11, long hdc in next st, sc in each of next 2 , (long hdc in next st, sc in next) twice. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 12:

Using 2 strands of Color C held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, sc in each of next 8 sts, sk next sc, (long hdc in base, sc in top, long hdc in base) of next sc, sk next sc, sc in next, sk next sc, (long hdc in base, sc in top, long hdc in base) of next sc, sk next sc, sc in each of rem 9 sts across. Fasten off. Turn.
Row 13:
Rep Row 11.

## Row 14:

Using 2 strands of Color D held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, sc in each of next 6 sts, sk next sc, *(long hdc in base, sc in top, long hdc in base) of next sc, sk next sc, sc in next, sk next sc, rep from * once, (long hdc in base, sc in top, long hdc in base) of next sc, sk next sc, sc in each of rem 7 sts across. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 15:

Rep Row 11.

## Row 16:

Rep Row 8.

## Row 17:

Rep Row 9.

## Row 18:

Using 2 strands of Color B held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, sc in each of next 7 sts, (sc in top, long hdc in base) of next sc, sk next sc, sc in next, sk next sc, (long hdc in base, sc in top, long hdc in base) of next sc, sk next sc, sc in next, sk next sc, (long hdc in base, sc in top) of next sc, sc in each of rem 8 sts across. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 19:

Rep Row 7.

## Row 20:

Using 2 strands of Color C held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, sc in each of next 9 sts, (sc in top, long hdc in base) of next sc, sk next sc, sc in next, sk next sc, (long hdc in base, sc in top) of next sc, sc in each of rem 10 sts across. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 21:

Using 2 strands of Color A held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, long hdc in next st, sc in next, (long hdc in next
st, sc in each of next 5) 3 times, (long hdc in next st, sc in next) twice. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 22:

Rep Row 6.
Row 23:
Using 2 strands of Color A held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, long hdc in next st, sc in next, long hdc in next st, sc in each of next 6 , long hdc in each of next 5 sts, sc in each of next 6 , (long hdc in next st, sc in next) twice. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 24:

Using 2 strands of Color E held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, sc in each of rem 24 sts across. Fasten off. Turn.

## Row 25:

Rep Row 3.

## Row 26 (Border):

Using 2 strands of Color A held tog, join thread with sc in 1st st, *ch 1 , sc in center of sc just made, sk long hdc, sc in next sc, rep from * across. Fasten off. Turn.

## Border:

With WS facing, working along opposite side of foundation, and holding 2 strands of Color A held tog, join thread with sc in 1st ch, *ch 1, sc in center of sc just made, sk next ch, sc in next, rep from * across. Fasten off. Turn.

## FRINGE

Tie first three rows (Border, foundation ch \& Row 1) together in an overhand knot to form fringe, then tie two rows at a time together across remainder of side (Rows 2-3, 4-5, etc.), finishing with the last three
rows tied together (Rows 24-26). Repeat on opposite side.

When all fringe has been knotted, trim fringe evenly to $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ or desired length.
