## SHELL HAT



### Skill Level:

Beginner

### Materials:

- Worsted weight cotton yarn, 2 oz. (56.7 g) balls:
  - Taupe – 1 ball
- Size H (5.00 mm) and size I (5.50 mm) crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge

### Gauge:

Rows 1-2

3¼" diameter

### Special Stitches:

Stitches noted in *bold italics* are defined on the last page.

### Begin:

Using size I crochet hook, ch 6, join with sl st to form ring.

### Rnd 1:

Ch 4, (dc in ring, ch 1) 11 times, with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-4.

### Rnd 2:

Ch 3, dc in same st, ch 1, \*2 dc in next dc, ch 1, rep from \* around, join with sl st in top of beg ch 3.

### Rnd 3:

Ch 3, dc in next st, ch 1, \*(2 dc in next dc, ch 1) twice, † dc in each of next 2 dc, ch 1, rep from \* 4 times, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in top of beg ch 3.

### Rnd 4:

Ch 3, dc in next st, \*ch 1, sk next dc, 2 dc in next, (dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-1 sp, 2 dc in next dc, ch 1, † sk next dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, rep from \* 4 times, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in top of beg ch 3.

### Rnd 5:

Ch 3, dc in next st, \*ch 1, sk 2 dc, dc in next, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, † sk 2 dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, rep from \* 4 times, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in top of beg ch 3.

### Rnds 6-9:

Rep Rnd 5.

### Rnd 10:

Using size H crochet hook, ch 3, dc in next st, \*ch 1, sk 2 dc, dc in next, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, † sk 2 dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, rep from \* 4 times, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in top of beg ch 3, ch 4, turn.

### Rnd 11:

Using size I crochet hook, \*sk next 2 dc, dc in next, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, † sk 2 dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, ch 1, rep from \* 4 times, then from \* to † once, sk 2 dc, dc in next, join with sl st in 3rd ch of turning ch-4.

### Rnd 12:

Ch 4, \*sk next 2 dc, dc in next, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in ch-2 sp, dc in next dc, ch 1, † sk 2 dc, dc in each of next 2 dc, ch 1, rep from \* 4 times, then from \* to † once, sk 2 dc, dc in next, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 4.

### Rnd 13:

Ch 1, sc in same st, \*sk ch, sc in each of next 3 dc, 3 sc in ch-2 sp, sc in each of next 3 dc, sk ch-sp, † sc in each of next 2 dc, rep from \* 4 times, then from \* to † once, sc in next dc, join with sl st in beg sc. Fasten off. Weave in threads.

Fold Rnds 11-13 to outside of hat for brim.



## ROSETTE HAT



### Skill Level:

Beginner

### Materials:

- Worsted weight cotton yarn, 2 oz. (56.7 g) balls:
  - Cream – 1 ball
- Size I (5.50 mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge

### Gauge:

Rows 1-3

3½" diameter

### Special Stitches:

Stitches noted in *bold italics* are defined on the last page.

### Begin:

Using size I crochet hook, ch 6, join with sl st to form ring.

### Rnd 1:

Ch 1, (sc in ring, ch 1) 6 times, join with sl st in beg sc.

### Rnd 2:

Ch 4, dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, \*dc in sc, ch 1, dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, rep from \* around, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 4.

### Rnd 3:

Ch 3, dc in same st, ch 1, \*sk ch-sp, 2 dc in dc, ch 1, rep from \* around, join with sl st in beg ch 3.

### Rnd 4:

Ch 4, dc in next dc, ch 1, \*sk ch-sp, dc in dc, ch 1, dc in next dc, ch 1, rep

from \* around, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 4.

#### Rnd 5:

Ch 2, \*hdc in ch-sp, ch 1, sk dc, 2 hdc in ch-sp, ch 1, sk dc, hdc in ch-sp, hdc in dc, ch 1, hdc in ch-sp, hdc in dc, ch 1, sk ch-sp, hdc in dc, hdc in ch-sp, ch 1, † hdc in dc, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in top of beg ch 2.

#### Rnd 6:

Sl st in next hdc, ch 1, 2 sc in next ch-sp, \*ch 2, sk 2 hdc, 2 sc in next ch-sp, rep from \* around, join with hdc in beg sc.

#### Rnd 7:

Ch 1, (sc, ch 3, sc) around joining-hdc, \*(sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-sp, rep from \* around, join with sl st in beg sc.

#### Rnd 8:

Ch 1, (sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-sp, rep from \* around, join with sl st in beg sc.

#### Rnds 9-15:

Rep Rnd 8.

#### Rnd 16:

Ch 1, \*2 sc in next ch-sp, ch 2, sc *in center of sc* just made, rep from \* around, join with sl st in beg sc. Fasten off. Weave in threads.

#### Rosette:

Ch 12, 6 hdc in 3rd ch from hook, [(sc, 4 dc) in next ch] 3 times, (sc, hdc, 3 *htr*) in next, [(hdc, 5 *htr*) in next ch] 4 times, (hdc, sl st) in last ch. Fasten off leaving a 12" tail for sewing. Position petals as desired. Tack into place, then sew onto side of hat using 12" tail.

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## PINEAPPLE HAT



#### Skill Level:

Easy

#### Materials:

- Cotton crochet thread, size 3, 100 yd. (91.5 m) balls:
  - Medium Brown (Color A) – 1 ball
  - Light Brown (Color B) – 1 ball
- Size F (3.75 mm) and G (4.00 mm) crochet hooks or size needed to obtain gauge

#### Gauge:

Rows 1-3  
3¼" diameter  
Center dc to center dc

#### Special Stitches:

Stitches noted in *bold italics* are defined on the last page.

#### Begin:

Using Color A and size F crochet hook, ch 6, join with sl st to form ring.

#### Rnd 1:

Ch 4, 2 dc in ring, ch 1, \*dc in ring, ch 1, 2 dc in ring, ch 1, rep from \* twice, join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch-4.

#### Rnd 2:

Ch 1, sc in same st, \*ch 2, 2 dc in each of next 2 dc, ch 2, † sc in next dc, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg sc.

#### Rnd 3:

Ch 1, (sc, ch 3, sc) in same st, \*ch 2, 2 dc in each of next 4 dc, ch 2, † (sc, ch 3, sc) in sc, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg sc.

#### Rnd 4:

Sl st in ch-3 sp, ch 1, sc in same sp, \*ch 2, dc in dc, (ch 1, dc in next dc) 7 times, ch 2, † sc in ch-3 sp, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg sc.

#### Rnd 5:

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 3, (sc in dc, ch 3) 8 times, † [yo, insert hook in sc, yo, pull up loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on hook, yo, insert hook in same sc, yo, pull up loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on hook, yo, pull thru all loops on hook – *dc2tog* made], rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg dc.

#### Rnd 6:

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, (sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3) 7 times, † *dc2tog* in dc2tog, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg dc.

#### Rnd 7:

Ch 2, (dc, ch 1, *dc2tog*) in same st, \*ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, (sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3) 6 times, † (*dc2tog*, ch 1, *dc2tog*) in dc2tog, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg dc.

#### Rnd 8:

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 1, dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, *dc2tog* in dc2tog, ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, (sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3) 5 times, † *dc2tog* in dc2tog, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg dc.

#### Rnd 9:

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 2, 2 dc in dc, ch 2, *dc2tog* in dc2tog, ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, (sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3) 4 times, † *dc2tog* in dc2tog, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg dc.

#### Rnd 10:

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 2, 2 dc in each of next 2 dc, ch 2, *dc2tog* in

dc2tog, ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, (sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3) 3 times, † **dc2tog** in dc2tog, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg dc.

**Rnd 11:**

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 2, 2 dc in each of next 4 dc, ch 2, **dc2tog** in dc2tog, ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, (sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3) twice, † **dc2tog** in dc2tog, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg dc.

**Rnd 12:**

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 2, dc in dc, (ch 1, dc in next dc) 7 times, ch 2, **dc2tog** in dc2tog, ch 1, sk ch-3 sp, dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, † **dc2tog** in dc2tog, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg dc.

**Rnd 13:**

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 3, (sc in dc, ch 3) 8 times, † [yo, insert hook in dc2tog, yo, pull up loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on hook, yo, insert hook in same st, yo, pull up loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on hook, yo, insert hook in next dc2tog, yo, pull up loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on hook, yo, insert hook in same st, yo, pull up loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on hook, yo, pull thru all loops on hook – **dc4tog** made], rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, **dc2tog** in dc2tog, join with sl st in beg dc, changing to Color B.

**Rnd 14:**

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, (sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3) 7 times, † **dc2tog** in dc2tog, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg dc.

**Rnd 15:**

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, (sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3) 6 times, † (**dc2tog**, ch 1, **dc2tog**) in dc2tog, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, **dc2tog** in same st as beg dc, ch 1, join with sl st in beg dc.

**Rnd 16:**

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, (sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3) 5 times, **dc2tog** in dc2tog, ch 1, dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, † **dc2tog** in dc2tog, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg dc.

**Rnd 17:**

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, (sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3) 4 times, **dc2tog** in dc2tog, ch 2, 2 dc in dc, ch 2, † **dc2tog** in dc2tog, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg dc, ch 2, turn.

**Rnd 18:**

Change to size G crochet hook, dc in same st, \*ch 2, 2 dc in each of next 2 dc, ch 2, **dc2tog** in dc2tog, ch 3, sk ch-3 sp, (sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3) 3 times, † **dc2tog** in dc2tog, rep from \*

twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg dc.

**Rnd 19:**

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 2, 2 dc in each of next 4 dc, ch 2, **dc2tog** in dc2tog, ch 3, sk ch-sp, (sc in next ch-3 sp, ch 3) twice, † **dc2tog** in dc2tog, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg dc.

**Rnd 20:**

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 2, dc in next dc, (ch 1, dc in next dc) 7 times, ch 2, **dc2tog** in dc2tog, ch 1, sk ch-3 sp, dc in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, † **dc2tog** in dc2tog, rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, join with sl st in beg dc.

**Rnd 21:**

Ch 2, dc in same st, \*ch 3, dc in 3rd ch from hook, sc in next dc, (ch 2, hdc in center of sc just made, sc in next dc) 7 times, ch 3, dc in 3rd ch from hook, † **dc4tog** over next 2 dc2tog (see Rnd 13), rep from \* twice, then from \* to † once, **dc2tog** in dc2tog, join with sl st in beg dc. Fasten off. Weave in threads.

Fold Rnds 18-21 to outside of hat for brim.

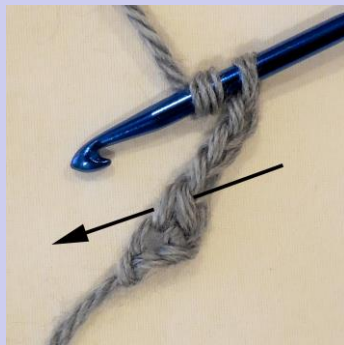
beg ..... beginning  
ch(s) ..... chain(s)  
dc ..... double crochet  
hdc ..... half double crochet  
htr ..... half treble  
rep ..... repeat  
rnd ..... round  
RS ..... right side  
sc ..... single crochet  
sp ..... space  
st(s) ..... stitch(es)  
WS ..... wrong side  
yo ..... yarn over

## SPECIAL STITCHES:

**dc2tog** – (yo, insert hook in specified st, yo, pull up loop, yo pull thru 2 loops on hook) twice, yo, pull thru all loops on hook

**dc4tog** – (yo, insert hook in specified st, yo, pull up loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on hook) 4 times, yo, pull thru all loops on hook

st **in center of sc** – work indicated st by inserting hook thru one horizontal bar and one vertical bar of sc (see example)



**htr** – yo (twice), insert hook in specified st, yo, pull up loop, yo, pull thru 2 loops on hook, yo, pull thru all loops on hook

## NOTES:

**Shell Hat** – Lily Sugar 'n Cream Twists, 2 oz. (56.7 gram) worsted weight cotton thread was used for model. The color used was Taupe Twists.

**Rosette Hat** – Lily Sugar 'n Cream, 2.5 oz. (70.9 gram) worsted weight cotton thread was used for model. The color used was Soft Ecru.

**Pineapple Hat** – DMC Senso Quick Finish, size 3, 100 yd. (91.5 m) cotton crochet thread was used in the following colors: Browns Variegated Rainbow Cotton and Linen Cotton.
